## History of December 29

- ♦ 1530 : Mughal ruler Babar's son Humayun became his successor.
- ♦ 1996: Guatemala and the leaders of the Guatemalan National Revolutionary Union sign an accord ending 36 years of civil war.
- ♦ 1972 : Metro rail work started in Calcutta.
- ◆ 1977: The world's largest open air theater drive opened in Bombay.
- ♦ 1911 : Mongolia became independent from the rule of the Qing dynasty.

## Current Affairs Related to 29 December

- Scientists discovered volcanic activity on a plain called Elysium Planitia on Mars. Scientist's research shows that volcanic activity may have occurred in the last 120 million years. Elysium Planitia is the youngest volcanic field on Mars and its study will help in better understanding of Mars.
- ↑ The Dynamic Stochastic General Equilibrium Model of the Reserve Bank of India has estimated retail inflation to be 4.8% in FY 2025. Based on the DSGE model's retail inflation forecast, the repo rate is expected to remain at 6.5% for most of FY2025.
- According to India Skills Report 2024, Kerala is the most preferred state to work in India. Kochi and Thiruvananthapuram have emerged as major employment destinations for the youth in the country. According to the report, both men and women in urban areas prefer to work regardless of their age.
- UNESCO has awarded the Rambagh Gate and Ramparts in Amritsar, Punjab. It has also awarded heritage conservation projects related to Church of the Epiphany in Haryana and Bikaner House in Delhi. Rambagh Gate and Ramparts project received the highest honour, Excellence Award.
- Vice President of India Jagdeep Dhankhar launched this new logo of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. The new logo was unveiled at the Global Professional Accountants Convention held recently in Gandhinagar. It consists of the letters CA in blue with the tricolor tick mark on a white background.
- Unique prehistoric rock art paintings have been discovered in Andriamelo Cave in western Madagascar. Pictorial art with human, animal figures and nature has been discovered in this cave. Some scenes relate to religious motifs from Egypt of the Ptolemaic period. Other findings of writing on the walls of this cave reveal connections to Ethiopia and the African Arab world.

- Textile Ministry launched Paat Mitro, a mobile application to provide important information about MSP and agronomy to jute farmers. It will provide information on latest farming practices and minimum support prices, jute grade standards, farmer centric schemes like Jute iCare, weather forecast, etc.
- Lok Sabha passes Telecom Bill 2023. This Bill will replace the Indian Telegraph Act 1885, the Indian Wireless Telegraphy Act 1933 and the Telegraph Wire Act 1950. The objective of this bill is to reform the regulatory and licensing regime for telecommunications. Also, this bill will remove obstacles in the creation of telecommunication infrastructure.
- Suzlon Group has finalized a key agreement with REC Limited, which aims to enhance working capital capacity. These strategic partnerships are important to execute current orders and future projects. This strategic partnership is set to enhance Suzlon's ability to meet its working capital needs, which is critical to execute its extensive current order book and potential future projects.
- ♦ MediaTek and Nvidia, semiconductor leaders, have united to advance AI in the automotive industry, transforming in-car experiences and setting new standards for smart vehicles. Semiconductor powerhouses MediaTek and Nvidia have formed a strategic partnership aimed at bringing artificial intelligence to the forefront of the automotive industry.
