History of April 24

- ♦ 1998: The Indian cricket team won the Coca-Cola Cup by defeating Australia by six wickets in Sharjah.
- ♦ 1970: The first Dojo satellite, Dong Fang Hang, was launched

- 1815 : The Gorkha Regiment, considered to be the first and bravest battalion of the Indian Army is 200 years old.
- ◆ 1954 : Relations between Australia and the Soviet Union ended.

Current Affairs Related to 24 April

- In an important step towards upgrading India's rail infrastructure, preparations are underway to introduce original indigenous stations in the country capable of reaching speeds of more than 250 kmph. This extraordinary first is set to revolutionize highend manufacturing in India, showcasing the country's engineering skills journey and equipment technology every quarter.
- Nestlé's claims of adding sugar and honey to infant cereals and milk products sold in low- and middle-income countries will be investigated by FSSAI. According to an investigation published in The Guardian, Nestle added sugar to its Nido and Cerelac product lines, which are distributed in Latin America, Asia and Africa. Sugar was added in the form of sucrose or honey. Public Eye investigated in collaboration with the International Baby Food Action Network. Public Eye is a Swiss investigative agency.
- Renowned economist of national and international repute, Utsa Patnaik, has been selected for the Malcolm Adisesia Award 2023. The Malcolm and Elizabeth Edessa Trust gives this award every year. The prestigious national award is presented to outstanding social scientists.
- ◆ DRDO successfully flight tests indigenous technology cruise missile. The missile was test fired from the Integrated Test Range, Chandipur, off the coast of Odisha. The flight of the missile has also been monitored by Indian Air Force's Su-30-Mk-1 aircraft. This successful flight test has also demonstrated the reliable performance of the indigenous propulsion system, developed by the Gas Turbine Research Establishment.
- 6 year old Takshvi Vaghani has made a Guinness World Record in skating. Takvi Wagon holds the record for lowest limb skating at 25 meters 16 cm. Takshavi holds the world record of more than 25 meters in lowest limbo skating.

- The United Nations Conference on Trade and Development estimates that India's GDP growth rate in 2024 will be 6.5 percent, which is slightly lower than last year's 6.7 percent. The findings are attributable to strong public investment and a strengthening service sector. The report highlights the trend of multinational corporations shifting manufacturing to India, thereby promoting joint ventures.
- The World Health Organization has updated the terminology for pathogens. The main purpose of this change is to help identify and respond to existing and new airborne pathogens. There is currently no common terminology to describe the transmission of these pathogens, which has been particularly challenging during the global COVID-19 pandemic.
- New FDI rules for the space sector notified by the Center ahead of Elon Musk's visit. Amendments to the Foreign Direct Investment Policy in the space sector have been notified by the Government to attract offshore investors in the satellite manufacturing and satellite launch vehicle sectors. It sets out liberalized entry pathways and provides clarity for FDI in satellites, launch vehicles and related systems or sub-systems, construction of space ports for launching and receiving spacecraft and manufacturing of space-related components and systems. Is.
- India's electronics industry experienced significant growth in aggregate, reaching \$29.12% in FY 2023-2024, an average growth of 23.6% compared to the previous year. The increase is particularly significant amid a decline of 3% in the country's total opposition.
- The Indian team has won 2 silver and 2 bronze medals in the 13th European Girls Mathematical Olympiad 2024. This Olympiad is held in Tskaltubo, Georgia.




