History of 10th May

- ◆ 1526: Babur entered Akbarabad, the capital of India, in the first battle after the victory.
- ♦ 1857 : India's first war of independence began.
- 2005: Lahore Amritsar bus service started in India and Pakistan.
- 1857: The first battle against the British Army, about 60 km away from Delhi, the heroes of Bharat Mata, working for the British Army, martyred 50 British friends.
- ♦ 1980 : The Iranian Embassy in London was captured.

Current Affairs Related to 10th May 2024

- Sanjeev Nautiyal will be the new MD and CEO of Ujjivan SFB with effect from July 1, 2024. He has been appointed for a tenure of three years. Presently he is an independent director of Life Insurance Corporation of India and serves as a consultant in various organizations. He will replace Itira Davis, who took office in January 2022. He will be the third MD and CEO of Ujjivan SFB Bank in five years.
- Meryl Streep will be presented with an honorary Palme d'Or at the opening ceremony of the Cannes Film Festival. Streep, who won Best Actress at Cannes in 1989, will attend the opening ceremony of the 77th edition of the Cannes Film Festival. Previously the Cannes Honorary Palme d'Or was awarded to Jeanne Moreau, Marco Bellocchio, Catherine Deneuve, Jean-Pierre Léaud, Jane Foda, Agnes Varda, Forest Whitaker and Jodie Foster.
- Maharashtra Forest Department has decided to shift some tigers from Tadoba Andhari Tiger Reserve to Sahyadri Tiger Reserve in Chandrapur. The translocation plan was approved by the National Tiger Conservation Authority in October 2023. In the initial phase, a new tiger or a pair of male and female tigers will be transferred to the Sahyadri Tiger Reserve. Sahyadri Tiger Reserve is one of only five tiger reserves with zero tigers.
- ♦ The Central Government has appointed retired judge Sanjay Kumar Mishra as the Chairman of the Goods and Services Tax Appellate Tribunal. The move aims to streamline the resolution of issues related to Atomic Energy Corporation for minorities. The institution, set up by the government on the basis of a search-cum-selection committee, comes with a salary of Rs 2.50 lakh per month for four years.
- ♦ India has been ranked 159th among 180 countries in the latest annual World Press Freedom Index released by Reporters Without Borders, an international NGO. Earlier in the list of 2023, India was at 161st position.

- India's first astrotourism campaign, Nakshatra Sabha, was launched by Uttarakhand Tourism. This is an initiative designed to provide a comprehensive astrotourism experience. The aim of the initiative is star observation and the participants are to engage in various activities like star observation, special solar observations, astrophotography competitions and camping under the stars. The Nakshatra Sabha is scheduled to begin in early June at George Everest in Mussoorie and continue till mid-2025.
- ♦ Under the Hindu Marriage Act, the Supreme Court ruled that Hindu marriages cannot be registered in the absence of a valid ceremony. According to the bench of Justices BV Nagarathna and Augustine George Masih, Hindu marriage is considered a sacrament. The bench said that Hindu marriage should be recognized as a highly respected institution in Indian society.
- ♦ Flying Wedge Defense is a defense and aerospace technology firm. According to the company, this is India's first indigenous bomber unmanned aircraft. The price of indigenous FWD-200B is only Rs 25 crore. U.S. The price of Predator is around Rs 250 crores.
- The reappointment of Atanu Chakraborty as parttime chairman of HDFC Bank has been approved by the RBI for a period of three years till May 4, 2027. As a member of IAS in Gujarat cadre, Chakraborty has served the Government of India for 35 years. During the financial year 2019-2020, he worked on various posts including Secretary in the Department of Economic Affairs, Ministry of Finance, Government of India.
- ♦ Shashi Krishna Singh, a 2010 batch officer of the Indian Railway Traffic Service, has been appointed Secretary, Ministry of Factories under the National Jute Board in Kolkata.
- ◆ The 26th ASEAN India Senior Officials Meeting was held in New Delhi. India's country coordinator for ASEAN-India dialogue relations is Singapore. The meeting was attended by senior officials and representatives of all ASEAN member states and Timor Leste.


