- ♦ UBS estimates India's real GDP growth rates for fiscal years 2025 and 2026 at 7% and 6.8%, respectively. Despite this, India is expected to retain its position as one of the fastest growing global industries. The report highlights continued growth momentum in the first three quarters of FY2024, driven by cyclical recovery and reform reforms.
- ♦ Meghalaya State Skill Development Society launches Skillrate Connect in collaboration with Ministry of Skill Acquisition and Knowledge Awareness and Skill Development and Entrepreneurship for Livelihood Promotion. Several skills initiatives have been launched in Meghalaya in the last five years. Nearly 70,000 youth are joining the workforce every year in Meghalaya. Youth can choose youth skill programs through various providers available on the portal. Skill development of youth will reduce the unemployment rate.
- ◆ United States Coast Guard Ship Bartholome arrived at Port Blair for joint exercises to strengthen bilateral cooperation. Sea Defenders 2024 Codenamed WAL, this joint exercise was conducted off the coast of Port Blair. During the exercise, scenarios involving piracy and challenging asymmetric threats were simulated. Additionally, a simulated medical evacuation procedure was also conducted to increase readiness in emergency situations.
- India has been awarded the prestigious Measles & Rubella Champion Award by the Measles & Rubella National Championship. The award reflects India's instrumental role in preventing measles and rubella outbreaks.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi presented the first National Creator Award at the India Museum in New Delhi. The event marked an important milestone in the lectures by various influential contributors and celebration of their birthdays.

- The Department of Science and Technology in collaboration with T-Hub has launched the Machine Learning and Artistic Scientific Technology Hub in Residents. The objective of this initiative is to accelerate musical innovation, facilitate creativity and promote a supportive orchestra mechanism. Center of Excellence MATH I aims to create more than 500 AI related jobs by 2025.
- The Indian government led by Prime Minister Narendra Modi has approved a new investment of \$1.24 billion. Its first goals began with the creation of a pan-India Torch Mechanism, incorporating India's technological strengths and promoting innovation in architecture. A powerful high performance system developed to serve as the Central Torch Restaurant of India.
- ↑ The great fast bowler James Anderson, who took the most wickets for England in Test history, has made a big achievement in his name. Here Anderson took the 700th wicket of his Test career by dismissing Kuldeep Yadav. He is the first fast bowler in the world to achieve this feat, while he is the third bowler overall.
- Rabb Prasad Goyal, Director, NHPC, has assumed the additional charge of Chairman and Managing Director of NHPC Limited, a leading hydropower company of India and an 'A' Enterprise under the Government of India. This transition marks a significant moment in the company's leadership, bringing Goyal's extensive experience and expertise to the fore. Goyal's journey within NHPC began on 18 November 1988 as a finance professional.
- India was honored with the prestigious Measles and Rubella Champion Award at the Red Cross Head-quarters in Washington DC, USA for its tireless efforts to combat the disease Measles and Rubella. The award was received by Sripriya Ranganathan, Ambassador and Deputy Chief of Mission in Washington DC, on behalf of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India.
