Current Affairs Related to 12th July 2024

- Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited, a Maharatna and Fortune Global 500 company, proudly announces its role as the Official Principal Partner of the Indian Olympic Association for four years from the Paris Olympics in 2024 to the Los Angeles Olympics in 2028. BPCL's partnership aims to respect and support the fair spirit of Indian athletes, who hail from underprivileged backgrounds in many countries. This collaboration reflects BPCL's progress in showcasing sporting talent and promoting national unity through initiatives designed to inspire and elevate Indian artists in Paris.
- Important duty concessions and safeguards for the petroleum and explosives sector were unveiled by Union Minister Piyush Goyal during stakeholder consultation in New Delhi. The stakeholder consultation was organized by the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade. The objective of the program was to increase efficiency within the Petroleum and Explosives Safety Organization and improve communication with industry stakeholders. During the program, Goyal announced 80% rebate in license fee for women entrepreneurs and 50% for MSMEs for licenses granted by PESO.
- Under the AGR-2 scheme of the government, the scheme will provide 50% assistance to farmers for the purchase of nano-fertilizers for the financial year 2024-2025. Shah unveiled the scheme during the Sahakar Se Samriddhi conference in Gandhinagar. Along with this, Shah initiated the payment of three farmers in the program and demonstrated the immediate implementation of the scheme.
- The Department of Skills for Persons with Disabilities, Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India, in collaboration with the National Finance and Development Corporation for Persons with Disabilities, is all set to host a remarkable event that celebrates the talent and craftsmanship of entrepreneurs and artists with disabilities from across the country. Are.

- NITI Aayog has constituted dedicated multi-sectorial committees to formulate policies and create a roadmap to achieve its goal of becoming a net zero economy by the year 2070. This comes three years after India announced its goal of becoming a net zero economy by 2070. NITI Aayog has formed 6 working groups. These groups will focus on developing policy frameworks, working models for key areas such as macroeconomic indicators, climate finance, critical minerals and social aspects of energy transition.
- In an important initiative towards enhancing the safety, quality and efficiency of kitchen utensils, the Government of India has made the Bureau of Indian Standards guidelines mandatory for stainless steel and aluminum utensils. According to the quality control order issued on March 14, 2024 by the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade, Ministry of Commerce and Industry, ISI mark will be mandatory for such utensils.
- an agreement for aerospace education and research. A definitive agreement was signed at Rail Bhawan, New Delhi following the signing of the MoU in September 2023. Minister of Railways, Information & Broadcasting, Electronics and IT Shri Ashwini Vaishnav and other officials were present at the signing of the agreement.
- There has been no change in the Cabinet Committee on Security, which includes Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Defense Minister Rajnath Singh, Home Minister Amit Shah, Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman and External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar. There has also been no change in the Appointments Committee of the Cabinet, which includes Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Home Minister Shah.
- ◆ Vidyut Ranjan Sarangi has been appointed Chief Justice of Jharkhand High Court, replacing Chief Justice of Jharkhand High Court Sanjay Kumar Mishra, who will retire on December 28, 2023.


