History of 17th July

- ♦ 1489: Nizam Khan was declared the Sultan of Delhi in the name of Sikandar Shah Lodi II.
- ◆ 1947: The Indian passenger ship Ramdas sank in a storm near Mumbai. 625 people died.
- 1948: Women in the country were declared eligible for any level of civil services including the Indian Administrative Service and the Indian Police Service.
- ♦ 1950 : India's first plane crashed in Pathan Kot.

Current Affairs Related to 17th July 2024

- Indian Air Force will participate in the multinational military exercise. Reached Royal Australian Air Force Base Darwin, Australia on behalf of Indian Air Force to participate in military exercise Pitch Black 2024. This military exercise is being conducted from 12 July to 2 August. Pitch Black is a biennial, multinational exercise conducted by the RAF. The event will be the largest in the 43-year history of X-Pitch Black.
- ♦ The Reserve Bank of India has introduced its quarterly Order Book Inventory and Capacity Utilization Survey for the manufacturing sector, which is aimed at informing monetary policy designs. Since 2008, this survey has provided important information to manufacturing companies across major brands such as new orders, production levels and capacity utilization. Data is collected on new orders received, order backlog and first orders received during the survey quarter.
- Minister of State for Defence, Shri Sanjay Seth inaugurated the GRSE Accelerated Rebound Nurturing Scheme at Garden Reach Shipbuilders and Engineers Limited in Kolkata. The objective of this initiative is to promote technology satisfaction for shipyard sheets and encourage innovation through Indian artifacts. Under these Bharat Bharat 2024 initiatives, MSMEs and poor are motivated to develop
 new solutions to improve technology capability in
 ship design and manufacturing sector.
- A high-level Indian conference led by Shri Lekh Ramachandran, Secretary, Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways participated in the 132nd session of the Council of the International Maritime Organization in London. In which various important issues and commitments for future global maritime operations were discussed. A unified membership of the IMO Council with those having the greatest interest in international maritime trade emphasized the urgent issue of abandonment of seafarers by India.

- The Defense Research and Development Organization has taken an important step towards promoting self-reliance in the defense sector, with seven new projects coming up under the Technology Development Fund Scheme. These projects are aimed at meeting the various requirements of the Armed Forces and Aerospace & Defense sectors, while encouraging the growth of industrial, especially micro, small and medium units and strike ups in these sectors.
- ♦ Kotak Mahindra AMC has launched Kotak BSE PSU
 Conformity Fund, a passive equity scheme simulating BSE PSU Conformity, consisting of 56 PSU stocks. The fund aims to take advantage of the strong gains that PSU stocks have shown recently. Through this fund one can participate in India's economic progress through a cost-effective investment vehicle, which is systematically managed by the fund.
- India's economic outlook in June 2024 shows significant growth led by strong performance in both the manufacturing and services sectors. The manufacturing manager index jumped, with strong hiring activity hitting a 19-year high. With this, the eight core industry index grew by 6.5% year-on-year in the initial months of FY2025, led by sectors like coal and power.
- ♦ Lieutenant General Shankar Narayan, NM, VSM takes over as the Commandant of the Army Hospital, widely recognized as the premier hospital of the Indian Armed Forces. This appointment marks a new chapter in the hospital's proud history and promises to bring a fresh perspective to military healthcare.
- ♦ Ireland has overtaken Mauritius to secure the fourth position among preferred destinations for foreign portfolio investors sending funds to India till June 30, 2024.




