- ◆ 1789: The East India Company made a treaty with the Peshwa and the Nizam against Tipu Sultan.
- ♦ 1879 : Freedom fighter Basudev Balwant Phadke was arrested.
- ♦ 1947: The Indian Independence Bill was proposed before the British Parliament. Under which the country was divided into India and Pakistan.
- ♦ 2001 : Instructions were given by India to release the citizens of Pakistan.

Current Affairs Related to 4th July 2024

- UP National Security Advisor Vikram Mishra will take over as Foreign Secretary on July 15, the government announced on June 28. Mishri, a former Indian ambassador to China, will replace current Foreign Secretary Vinay Mohan Kwatra. The Ministry of Personnel announced that 1989 batch Indian Foreign Service officer Vikram Misri will be appointed as Deputy National Security Advisor in the National Security Council Secretariat to the post of Foreign Secretary with effect from July 15, 2024.
- The Government of India has contributed a huge contribution of 1,169,746 US voters to the Hindi/ UN Project to expand the use of Hindi in the United Nations. The Government of India is making continuous efforts to increase the use of Hindi in the United Nations. As part of these campaigns, the Hindi/UN Project was launched in 2018 in partnership with the United Nations Department of Public Information. Its purpose was to promote the United Nations in the Hindi language, as well as to create greater awareness among millions of Hindi-speaking people about global issues.
- Adani Defense and Aerospace has signed an agreement with Thales Group to manufacture 70 mm rockets locally. This is in line with the Make in India initiative of the Government of India, which aims to increase self-reliance in defense production. Group company Adani Defense and Aerospace will manufacture 70 mm rockets for Rudra and Prachanda helicopters, considered extremely important for the Indian Air Force.
- Defense Research and Development Organization has successfully completed six consecutive development trials of High Speed Expendable Aerial Update Exercise with improved fitness model. Prakash is a high speed expendable air target which is being developed in AD. This provides a real threat to the practice of weapons. The exercise is designed to evolve into an ADE for autonomous flight with the help of an autopilot.

- A circular has been issued by the Central Board of Indirect Taxes and Customs for the launch of Exchange Rate Automation Module. The current manual process will now be replaced by an automated system to collect and publish exchange rate information and will be effective from July 4. ERAM is an important milestone towards trade facilitation. Through this, exchange rates of 22 currencies will now be published online in advance for ease of doing business for all importers and exporters.
- ◆ Under a significant amendment to the Central Civil Services Rules 1972, commissioning mothers opting for surrogacy will now be entitled to 180 days of maternity leave. The amendment will also extend child care leave to commissioning mothers with less than two surviving children, a major change from the previous 50-year-old rule. Maternity leave under the commissioning rules has also been prescribed for a period of 15 days.
- Railway Protection Force reporter Manoj Yadav has launched a mental app, which has been designed by the RPF mental team. The objective of this app is to provide detailed information on three new criminal laws Indian Trust Code 2023, Indian Civil Protection Code 2023A and Indian Evidence Act 2023. This app aims to educate and empower RPF personnel by providing them comprehensive information on new and old criminals, which is considered important in the operations of RPF.
- Jaipur Military Station has become the second military station in India to have a road made of plastic waste. This road was inaugurated by Major General R.S. Gondar, General Officer Commanding 61 Sub Area. This road is 100 meters long and extends from Sagat Singh Road Under Bridge to Cubs Corner Complex. This initiative is in line with the Indian Army's policy of creating sustainable and green military stations.
