- Prime Minister Narendra Modi has strengthened his dominance in the digital sphere and has become the first world leader to cross the 2 crore subscriber mark on YouTube. - ♦ The Ministry of Mines of India has identified about 22 blocks of critical minerals. These important mineral reserves include cobalt, titanium, gallium, vanadium, tungsten, lithium and some rare earth elements. Most of these minerals are used in the electronic industry, making lithium ion batteries, paints and plastics. It is also used in making special alloys for military and defense purposes.
- ♦ Prime Minister Narendra Modi chaired the third National Conference of Chief Secretaries in Delhi. The National Conference of Chief Secretaries is organized to encourage participatory governance and partnership between the Central and State Governments.
 - India Women finished their first home season of Test cricket in 28 years with a historic first win over Australia in the one-off Test match in Mumbai. This victory was an important achievement for the Indian team. Playing more than one Test on home ground for the first time since 1995, Indian women performed brilliantly and did not make the slightest mistake. The team followed through on its promise of playing positive cricket, facing challenges and setting the bar against tough opponents like Australia and England.
