History of January 16

Current Affairs Related to 16 January

- NewSpace India Limited is planning to launch GSAT20 satellite. The satellite will be launched on
 SpaceX's Falcon-9 rocket in the second quarter of
 2024. It will be wholly owned, operated and financed
 by NSIL.
- Indian Railways, a major player in the transportation sector, has reaffirmed its commitment towards environmental sustainability by renewing its MoU with the Confederation of Indian Industry. The collaboration aims to reduce energy and water consumption, ultimately reducing greenhouse gas emissions. This is the third consecutive term of partnership between Indian Railways and CII. The railway network has set an ambitious pace to achieve net zero carbon emissions by 2030 while strengthening its dedication to sustainable practices.
- REC Limited, a unit of the Power Ministry, has signed an MoU with Rail Vikas Nigam Limited to provide financial assistance of Rs 35,000 crore for various infrastructure projects over the next 5 years. The MoU was formalized through signatures of key personalities, with REC Director Shri Ajoy Chaudhary and RVNL Director Shri Rajesh Prasad playing key roles in signing the agreement.
- Researchers from the prestigious Indian Institute of Technology Madras and Mandi have made a significant achievement in the field of biotechnology. They have successfully metabolically engineered plant cells to boost the production of the anti-cancer drug camptothecin.
- The Department of School Education and Literacy, Ministry of Education, Government of India has launched Prema: An Experiential Learning Programme. This program is the cornerstone of the National Education Policy 2020. The goal is to provide a meaningful, unique and inspiring experience to all participants. Prema is a week long residential program for selected students of classes IX to XII.

- India has appointed seven skilled civil servants to important posts abroad, showcasing the country's global involvement. Notably, Shri Vikas Sheel, a seasoned bureaucrat, now Executive Director of the Asian Development Bank in Manila, emphasizes India's commitment to international development. Vikas Sheel, a 1994 batch Indian Administrative Service officer, is now the Executive Director at ADB.He brings valuable experience from his current role as Additional Secretary and Mission Director of Jal Jeevan Mission and contributes to India's representation in this prestigious institution.
- The Union Cabinet has recently approved declaring Ayodhya Airport as an international airport, an important development for the city. The airport will be named Maharishi Valmiki International Airport, Ayodhyadham, reflecting the historical and cultural importance of the region.
- The Indian Space Research Organization achieved a significant milestone by successfully testing a 100W series Polymer Electrolyte Membrane Fuel Cell based power system in its orbital platform, POEM3. This remarkable achievement occurred on the PSLV-C58 mission, which is an important step in the evaluation of fuel cell technology for future space missions. The primary objective of the experiment was to evaluate the operation of polymer electrolyte membrane fuel cells in the challenging environment of space.
- ♦ Similipal Kai Chutney from Mayurbhanj district of Odisha received the Geographical Indication tag. This chutney is made from red weaver ants. This chutney is popular in the region due to its healing properties. This chutney is considered important for the nutritional security of the tribal people.
- ♦ Randhir Jaiswal took charge as the official spokesperson of the Ministry of External Affairs. Shri Jaiswal has served in the Permanent Mission of India to the United Nations in Portugal, Cuba, South Africa and New York.
