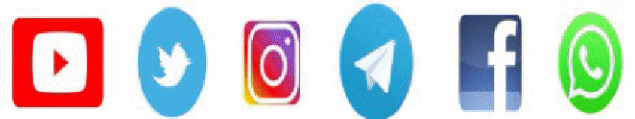

- ◆ **1918** : Hindi Sahitya Sammelan was organized in Indore under the chairmanship of Gandhiji and Hindi was celebrated as the official language through a resolution.
- ◆ **1915** : The British government awarded Rabindranath Tagore the title of knighthood.
- ◆ **1994** : Bharat Sahayata Club was renamed as 'Bharat Sahayata Stage'.
- ◆ **2005** : France supported India's candidature for the Security Council.

Current Affairs Related to 3rd June 2024

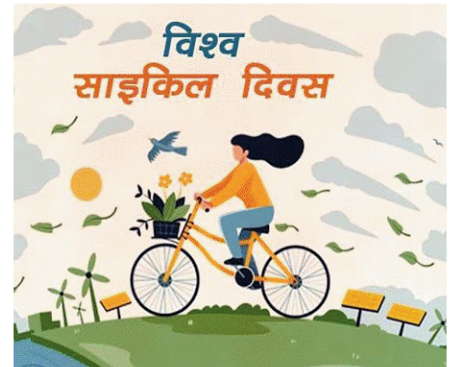
- ◆ India assumed the Chairmanship of the Colombo Process for 2024-2026. This is the first time that India has assumed the chairmanship of the Colombo Process since its inception. India seeks to promote safe, orderly and legal migration. The Colombo Process is a regional consultation process of migrant worker origin countries in South and East Asia. It serves as a platform for exchange of best practices regarding employment abroad.
- ◆ India's leading refilling company Reliance Industries has signed an important agreement with Russia's Rosneft. Under this deal, Reliance Rosneft will buy at least 3 million barrels of oil per month and pay for it in Russian rubles. The move coincides with Russian President Vladimir Putin's call on the need for alternative trade mechanisms amid the Western scenario.
- ◆ Cold Chain and Logistics Summit was organized by the Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce and Industry to discuss the future of cold chain logistics. The objective of this summit is to promote collaboration and innovation in developing an integrated, sustainable and efficient cold chain ecosystem for India's perishable goods industry.
- ◆ The Ministry of External Affairs, Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology and CSC e-Governance Services India Limited signed an MoU. This MoU was signed during the conclave of the National Workshop on Driving Transformation through UI/UX for Digital Governance. It aims to create synergy between CSC SPV and Ministry of External Affairs to provide e-Migrate services through CSCs in the country.
- ◆ According to scientists, Venus appears to be more volcanically active than before. Evidence of volcanic eruptions has emerged at two additional sites on Venus, according to a new analysis of decades-old radar images.
- ◆ The International Cricket Council has announced the ICC Player of the Month awards for April 2024. West Indies captain Hayley Matthews has been named the ICC Women's Player of the Month for her exceptional all-round performances, which will lead West Indies to a successful ODI and T20I series in Pakistan.
- ◆ Reliance Industries Limited has entered into a key technology partnership with Norway's Nel Esa to mark its entry into new energy investments. The alliance is poised to play a key role in facilitating RIL's transition to green energy, particularly through the production of green hydrogen. RIL finalized a technology licensing agreement under which it acquires a non-exclusive license in India for ASA's alkaline electrolyzers.
- ◆ Poonawalla Fincorp Limited in partnership with IndusInd Bank has launched co-branded IndusInd Bank Poonawalla Fincorp Elite RuPay Platinum Credit Card. This new card is designed to enhance the customer experience with rewards and subscriptions, and is available with no membership or annual fees. Users can redeem rewards on every Rs.100 spent including UPI Mouse, and avail 2.5x reward points on e-commerce Mouse.
- ◆ Indian Oil hands over Hydrogen Fuel Cell Bus to Indian Army to promote hydrogen and fuel cell technology for heavy duty e-mobility. Indian Oil also signed an MoU with the Indian Army to deploy hydrogen fuel cell technology for heavy duty e-mobility. The project will evaluate the performance of fuel cell electric buses for public transportation in the Delhi NCR region.
- ◆ Reserve Bank of India has launched Pravah Portal, Retail Direct Mobile Application and Fintech Repository to facilitate retail investors and other things.
