History of April 17

- ♦ 2008 : Four important treaties were signed between Brazil and India.

Current Affairs Related to 17 April

- Pilot Gopichand Thotakura is becoming the first Indian to travel to space as a tourist destination. He will travel to space as part of the crew for Space Company Blue Origin founder Jeff Bezos' New Shepard 25 mission. The flight date will be announced soon. Blue Origins reported that Gopi is a pilot and aviator who learned to fly before being a driver.
- China has changed the names of some places in Arunachal Pradesh, a move India rejected, saying assigning invented names would not change the fact that the state is and will always be an integral part of India. The Chinese Ministry of Civil Affairs released the fourth list of standardized geographical names of Jangnan, which Beijing claims is part of South Tibet.
- ◆ It highlights the worrying situation of soil erosion across India, revealing significant challenges and implications for agricultural productivity and environmental sustainability. The researchers used a modified universal soil loss equation to estimate all-India soil erosion.
- India has now emerged as the fourth largest exporter of digitally delivered services, with its share now accounting for more than a fifth of international trade in services. Data released by WTO in Global Trade Outlook and Statistics estimates India's exports of digitally delivered services to be worth \$257 billion in 2023, 17% more than the previous year.

- Indian Space Research Organization chief S.S. Somnath has revealed that the upcoming phase of Chandrayaan project is in progress, he aims that India's Chandrayaan project is on the way forward. He indicated that Chandrayaan-4 is the initial step towards India's mark to have an astronaut on the Moon by 2040.
- Trishakti Corps of Indian Army practiced firing antitank guided missiles at 17 thousand feet basement in the division. Missile firing contingents of the Army's Eastern Command and infantry units participated in this training. The statement said that the ATI troops demonstrated their capability to destroy the armored installation in a spectacular manner. Practice will make it easier to succeed in future missions in inaccessible and pipelined areas.
- The Supreme Court said that candidates contesting elections are not required to disclose every movable property owned by them or their dependents. The court said candidates would have to disclose information about assets that are of substantial value or represent a luxury lifestyle. The Supreme Court said that a voter does not have the full right to know about every asset of a candidate.
- According to a report released by think tank InfluenceMap, only 57 actors are responsible for 80% of carbon liberation from fossil forests and the world in the last seven years. These 57 entrepreneurs include world's oil, gas, coal and raw material producers. The report concludes that the net zero climate change target set in Paris in 2015 has not been achieved, and is not capable of achieving targets with significant impact.
- The research team of Dr. Aggarwal Eye Hospital has been honored with the prestigious Best Scientist Post Award at the 2024 Annual Meeting of the American Society for Cataract and Refractive Surgery.
