History of 24th June

- ♦ 1206: The first Sultan of Delhi Sultanate, Qutbuddin Aibak, was crowned.
- ♦ 1986: The government announced that unmarried mothers would also receive maternity leave under its employment scheme.
- ◆ 1961: India produced the HF 24 Flies supersonic fighter aircraft for the first time.
- ▶ 1564 : Rani Durgavati, one of the famous brave queens of Indian history, died.

Current Affairs Related to 24th June 2024

- Kerala's Kozhikode is all set to host the Malabar River Festival 2024, including the International White Water Kayaking Championships, from July 25 to 28. This exciting event aims to promote white water kayaking in the region and will be held at Thusaharagiri, Chalipuzha and Iruvazhinjipuzha. The high octane events and pre-events will feature over 100 national level kayakers from India and kayaking professionals from over 20 countries.
- ◆ Indian defense company Hindustan Aeronautics Limited has received an order for 156 Light Combat Helicopters from the Defense Ministry. A regulatory filing by CHL said the company has received a request for proposal for 156 Light Combat Helicopters from the Defense Ministry. Out of 156, 90 helicopters are for the Indian Army and 66 helicopters are for the Indian Air Force.
- ♦ The International Finance Corporation has agreed to invest \$105 million in non-convertible debentures of Brookfield's Bikaner Solar Power Project located in Rajasthan. IFC is a sole subsidiary of the World Bank Group that provides financing to private sector companies. Brookfield Global Transition Fund is building a 550 MW solar power project in two phases in Bikaner.
- ♦ Hyderabad-based space tech company Dhruva Space has completed its first mission with Thybolt-1 and Thybolt-2 satellites. These satellites have safely exited the orbit after completing 15,000 revolutions around the Earth. Launched by ISRO's PSLV C-54 in November 2022, this marvel is an important milestone for the company.
- ♦ Delhi International Airport Limited has launched a self-service mechanism aimed at enabling passengers to complete the process of depositing their luggage, collecting tags and printing boarding passes in less time.

- Cricketer Virat Kohli has reclaimed the top spot as India's most valuable celebrity brand, according to the Celebrity Brand Valuation Report 2023 released by global consultancy firm Kroll. Whose brand value is \$227.9 million. This increases their brand value by 30% to \$176.9 million in 2022.
- The Reserve Bank of India has indicted Central Bank of India and Sonali Bank Plc for violations related to customer security and KYC authentication. A fine of Rs 1.45 crore has been imposed on Central Bank of India, which includes irregularities like irregular debentures and irregular transactions. Similarly, a fine of Rs 96.4 lakh has been imposed on Sonali Bank PLC for non-compliance with KYC Update 2016.
- The Indian national ultimate frisbee team performed well at the Asia Pacific Beach Ultimate Championships, finishing runner-up to the Philippines after a tough match with a final score of 9.12. This is a historic milestone for Indian Ultimate Frisbee as the national team demonstrated significant growth and improvement on the international stage entering the finals for the first time.
- Renowned wildlife filmmaker Subbiah Nallamuthu has been awarded the prestigious 18th V. Shantaram Lifetime Achievement Award for his outstanding contribution in the field of non-feature and wildlife documentary filmmaking. The award was presented by L Murugan, Union Minister of State for Information and Broadcasting, at the inaugural ceremony of the 18th Mumbai International Film Festival in Mumbai, Maharashtra.
- Kottakkal Arya Vaidyashala a renowned Ayurvedic institute celebrated a significant milestone as its Managing Trustee and Chief Physician, P.Madhavankutty Varrier was conferred the degree of Honorary Doctor of Science by Kerala University of Health Sciences.




