NITIE Introduction

National Institute of Industrial Engineering (NITIE) was established as 'National Institute of Training in Industrial Engineering' by the Government of India in 1963. Recognized as one of the 15 Centres of Excellenceby the Ministry of HRD, Government of India, it is renowned as the top Indian school for operations and supply chain management. The following programmes are offered at NITIE:

- 1. Post Graduate Diploma in Industrial Engineering (PGDIE)
- 2. Post Graduate Diploma in Industrial Management (PGDIM)
- 3. Post Graduate Diploma in Industrial Safety and Environmental Management (PGDISEM)
- 4. Post Graduate Diploma in Manufacturing Management(PGDMM)
- 5. Post Graduate Diploma in Project Management(PGDPM)
- 6. Fellow Programme

NITIE Eligibility

Eligibility for PGDIE / PGDIM / PGDISEM / PGDMM / PGDPM

- Candidates should have an Engineering/Technology graduation degree in any branch with aggregate 60% marks (55% in case of SC/ST/PD candidates).
- Candidates who are currently in their final year of Engineering/Technology degree can also apply.
- Few seats in this program are for Sponsored candidates. The sponsored candidates should be from reputed an Industrial Organization/Academic Institution with at least 2 years of work experience.

Eligibility for Fellow Programme

- Masters degree or equivalent in Engineering/ Technology, Management, Economics, Commerce, Social Science, Life sciences and Pure Sciences with 60% aggregate marks (55% in case of SC/ST/PD candidates) from recognized University/ Institution, CA/ ICWA and ACS.
- Candidates appearing for their final examination in the respective disciplines can also apply.
- Candidates from Industry / Academia with above eligibility and a minimum of two years experience may also apply. They need to produce sponsorship certificate from the employer.



NITIE Admission Procedure

For PGDIE / PGDMM / PGDPM

- 1. Candidates are shortlisted on the basis of their GATE scores.
- 2. The shortlisted candidates are then called for a round of Group Discussion and Personal Interview.


For PGDIM / PGDISEM

- 1. Candidates will be shortlisted based on their CAT score.
- 2. The shortlisted candidates are then called for a round of Group Discussion and Personal Interview.



For Fellow Programme

- 1. Candidates are required to fill up an online application form and upload their research proposals.
- 2. Candidates will be shortlisted on the basis of their educational qualification and research proposal.
- 3. Shortlisted candidates will appear for NITIE admission test and a Writing Skill test at the institute. This will be followed by a Research Presentation and Personal Interview



NITIE Eligibility and Selection Criteria for PGDIM/PGDSEM

The Eligibility Criteria for the PGDIM and PGDISEM course is mentioned below. Some of the major criteria that candidates should keep in mind while applying for the NITIE programs are:

- Should be a graduate from any branch of engineering or technology
- Should have a valid CAT Score
- Final year students can also apply to NITIE as long as they fulfill the criteria at the time of

For the 2020-2022 batch, the cutoff percentiles and the total number of seats under the PGDIM and PGDSEM programmes have been tabulated below:



PGDIM Programme

The total number of seats at NITIE for the PGDIM programme for the 2020-22 batch has been announced to be 304.

Note: The expected CAT Percentile cut offs represents the CAT Percentile that the candidate would require in order to get a call from NITIE according to recent trends. These trends may change from year to year.

Fees

The fees for the PGDIM and PGDISEM courses have been revised in 2019. The current tuition fees for the programs are Rs. 14,63,000 (Rs. 7,63,000 in the first year and Rs. 7,00,000 in the second year) over the course duration.



Engineering Background Diversity


