# History of December 16

- ♦ 1929: The Calcutta Electricity Supply Corporation started digging a canal within the Hooghly River.
- ♦ 1985 : The first Fast Breeder Test Reactor was established in Kalpakkam, Tamil Nadu.
- ♦ 1971 : After the ceasefire agreed between India and Pakistan, Bangladesh separated from Pakistan and became an independent nation.
- ◆ 1993 : Education for All Conference started in New Delhi.

# **Current Affairs Related to 16 December**

- The echo of economic and industrial development in Uttar Pradesh will now be heard on the global stage. Uttar Pradesh has also been invited to participate in the World Economic Forum as an annual summit to be held in Davos in January next year. The delegation aims to showcase the state's progress towards becoming a trillion-dollar economy. Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath has nominated a delegation to participate in the meeting to be held in Davos from January 15 to 19.
- ♦ The Central Government's decision to remove Article 370 from Jammu and Kashmir will remain intact. Constitution bench of 5 judges of the Supreme Court Article 370 was a temporary provision. It is clear from Articles 1 and 370 of the Constitution that Jammu and Kashmir is an integral part of India. All the provisions of the Indian Constitution can be applied there. Along with this, the Supreme Court ordered to hold assembly elections in the state by 30 September 2024.
- ◆ Indian activist Nikhil Dey, who pioneered policy reforms that empower Indian workers, was honored by the US government as the International Anti-Corruption Champion for 2023. The honor highlights his decades-long commitment to empowering farmers and workers while exposing corruption in the delivery of government services.
- Power, has received a loan of Euro 200 million from German bank KfW, marking a significant step in enhancing the distribution infrastructure of the discom. This agreement, marking REC's sixth credit line under Indo-German Development Cooperation, emphasizes the Corporation's commitment to strengthen the distribution infrastructure of Discoms in line with the Revised Distribution Sector Plan of the Government of India.
- Indian Army conducts table top exercise for ASEAN women peacekeepers.

- Youth for Unnati and Vikas with AI is a collaboration initiative of National e-Governance Division, Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Government of India and Intel India. GPAI Summit begins in New Delhi. This program is designed to equip youth with essential AI skills. The program is gaining attention for its innovative approach and commitment aimed at enabling a future-ready workforce. Youth for Unnati and Vikas with AI aims to promote deeper understanding of AI.
- A task force was formed by Thailand and Myanmar as border unrest increased. The task force will be established to promote humanitarian assistance to people displaced by the fighting between junta forces and rebel groups. The Myanmar side will soon send a working group to Thailand to discuss the matter.
- The 26th meeting of the Eastern Regional Council was held under the chairmanship of Union Home Minister Amit Shah in Patna, Bihar. He appealed to all the members to work in the spirit of cooperative federalism for all-round development. He said that the Eastern Regional Council has achieved great success in the last nine years, more than 1100 disputes have been settled through negotiations on this platform.
- ICGS Sajag enhanced maritime cooperation with UAE in Sadbhavna Yatra. The visit is part of the Goodwill Initiative in the Gulf Region, which will strengthen relations and cooperation between the Indian Coast Guard and UAE maritime agencies. The ship was welcomed by Colonel Marwan Mohammed Hassan Almazrookri of the UAE Coast Guard. The objective of the visit is to promote business relations, including joint exercises and interactions, and contribute to collaborative efforts in the maritime sector.
- ♦ Prime Minister Narendra Modi leads as the world's most popular leader with an approval rating of 76, leaving his peers behind by more than 10 points.




