## History of 22nd July

- ♦ 1947: The last rites of India were enacted by the Constitution of India.
- 1981: India's first geostationary satellite started functioning.
- ♦ 2012 : Pranab Mukherjee became the 13th President of India.
- ▶ 1999: The Equal Remuneration for Equal Work Scheme was implemented by the International Labor Organization.
- ◆ 1918 : India's first pilot, Indralal Roy, was killed in combat with Germany near London.

## Current Affairs Related to 22nd July 2024

- The 2024 Paris Olympic Games, to be held from July 26 to August 11, are set to be the largest ever held in France. This edition, officially known as the XXXIII Olympiad, featured several new events, raw change and a special focus on sustainability and youth initiation.
- SBI has launched its most stable Bank of India. The name of this precious Anmolkeem of 444 days is Amrit Verstikim. These friends are in the news due to their attractive daughter's rate. 7.25% per annum interest is being given on FD valve for 444 days on Amrit Vishisht Scotch. Whereas senior citizens will get benefit from the account with ? 50% interest rate and 7.75% rate interest rate. Investments can be made in this directive till 31 March 2025. In these banks you will get only 400 days Amrit Srishti Scotch Betiyas.
- ♦ The Asian Development Bank retained India's GDP growth forecast for the current financial year at 7 percent. Given more suggestions than usual, there is hope for improvement in agriculture. This comes after ADB's Asiatic International Monetary Fund slashed its principle growth projections for India to 7% compared to 6.8% in April.
- The Karnataka Cabinet has approved the Karnataka State Employment Bill 2024 for local candidates in industries, factories and other establishments. In this bill, 50% reservation for local people in management jobs and 75% in non-management posts has been made mandatory. This bill makes it mandatory that industries, factories and other establishments appoint 50% local candidates in management posts and 75% in non-management posts. For violating the provisions of this bill, a fine of up to Rs 25,000 can be imposed.
- The first malaria vaccine has been launched in Ivory Coast, Africa by the Serum Institute of India and Oxford University.

- North Eastern Region Agricultural Commodity E
  Connect web portal and mobile application has been
  launched. NERACE app aims to support agriculture
  and horticulture products and minor forest produce.
  This will provide farmers access to larger markets,
  better negotiation opportunities, etc.
- After the changes in the Council of Ministers, the Central Government has reorganized NITI Aayog, the highest public policy think tank of the Central Government. Prime Minister Narendra Modi remained the President, while economist Suman K. Berry served as the Vice President. The reconstituted NITI Aayog has four members and 15 Union ministers, including ministers from BJP ally Ashram, who will serve either as ex-officio members or as special invitees.
- In order to promote self-reliance in defense and reduce the burden of defense sector by public sector corporations, the Department of Defense Production, Ministry of Defense has prepared the fifth positive indigenous list of 346 enterprises in the country. The latest list includes 346 items, including systems and weapons important to the tribe. More than 12,300 monuments have been indigenized in the last three years.
- Malta's premier Roberta Metzola has achieved a historic second term as President of the European Parliament, making her the first woman to achieve this feat in the history of the EU Assembly. Metsola, known for her leadership and legislative stances, received significant support from the EU adjudicator, with 562 votes to 623 in her favour. Roberta Metzola called for the leadership of the European Parliament to take an active role.
- Minister Dr. Aamir Singh recently inaugurated Asia's first Health Research Associated Pre-Clinical Network Facility. This institute, which has been selected for Epidemic Preparedness Innovation, is significant as the first facility in Asia and 9th globally to test the level of pathogens.
