History of 4th May

- ◆ 1854 : India's first postage stamp was officially released.
- 1957: Indian historian Hemchandra Roy Choudhury passed away.
- ♦ 1983 : China conducted a nuclear test.

- ◆ 1896: The first edition of the Daily Mail newspaper was published in London.

Current Affairs Related to 4th May 2024

- According to a study by IITM, the temperature of the Indian Ocean is increasing. The Indian Ocean warmed by 1.2 degrees Celsius between 1950-2020. It will be 1.70% between 2020-2100. It will be 3.80°C hot. Waves are expected to increase ten times from the current average of 20 days per year to 220-250 days per year. Due to global warming, the tropical Indian Ocean will likely be in a near-permanent heatwave state. This will lead to coral bleaching, destruction of seagrass and loss of seagrass forests.
- The partnership is expected to be between European telecom industry body Industry Alliance 6G and India 6G Alliance. This collaboration will open doors for the development of 6G technologies. This will likely be equivalent to India's agreement for 6G with the US NextG alliance in September 2023. India 6G alliance and America's NextG alliance signed an MoU in September 2023. The aim of this MoU was to work on 6G wireless technology and develop a strong supply chain.
- India and Britain are close to an agreement on electric propulsion system for warships. The Government of India and the UK Government are discussing the possibility of an agreement to develop electric propulsion systems in India to power domestic warships. Presently diesel engines, gas turbines or steam turbines provide power to Indian warships. The electric propulsion capability is to power large warships with displacement of more than 6,000 tons.
- ♦ AI news anchor Sana wins International News Media Association's 2024 Global Media Award for AI-led newsroom transformation. It has been voted best in South Asia for AI-based newsroom transformation. It won the first position among national brands for best use of AI in customer facing products.

- Draft Master Direction is the name of the draft framework of Reserve Bank of India Direction 2024. It specifies that a company applying for authorization to operate as an EPT operator must have a minimum net worth of Rs 5 crore. Such an entity must always maintain a specified minimum net worth. If a non-clearance holds shares in such an entity, their ownership must comply with all relevant laws and regulations such as the Foreign Exchange Management Act of 1999.
- Gina is a teacher at Justus Our Own English High School, Sharjah Girls Branch. Justus is originally from Thiruvananthapurak, Kerala. Justus has been working continuously in UAE since 2005. He was recognized for his dedication to mentorship and charity. This year's competition received a record 14,840 nominations from 141 countries.
- Ministry of Mines signed an MoU with Shakti Sustainable Energy Foundation to provide knowledge support in the field of critical minerals. The summit was inaugurated under the auspices of the ministry. Mines Secretary Shri V L Kanta Rao presided over the inaugural ceremony of the summit designed to promote cooperation and innovation in beneficiation and processing of critical minerals.
- This roadmap provides criteria including net worth and NPA ratio for voluntary transition from small finance banks to universal banks. As part of the roadmap, RBI has set criteria such as minimum net worth of Rs 1000 crore and net profit in the last two financial years. Based on the six specified eligibility requirements, most of the ten applicants may not be ready to switch to Universal Bank until next year.


