## History of 29th March

- 1561: Akbar attacked Malwa's capital Sarangpur and defeated Bajbahadur.
- ◆ 1943 : Freedom fighter and leader Laxman Nayak was hanged in Berhampur jail.

**1857**: Sepoy Mangal Engels became known as a freedom fighter in the 1857 Netiva Infantry Rebellion in Bengal against British rule in India and the long-running freedom struggle.

## Current Affairs Related to 29th March 2024

- Eveready Industries India has announced its partnership with National Olympics gold medalist and
  men's world No. 1 Neeraj Chopra as its new brand
  ambassador. Through this support, Eveready aims
  to strengthen its growth towards innovation by
  launching the excellent new Ultima alkaline battery
  series. The brand hopes to enhance its connect with
  the youth by offering long-lasting and value-formoney solutions for high-drain appliances used by
  the new generation in India.
- Innovity Panels and Concerto Software have received Pavilion Aggregator License from the Reserve Bank of India, marking a significant milestone in India's digital payments landscape. Innovity PA operates Innovity Link, which serves 2500 offline services, while Cornesto Software's gateway Vega is in the league of specialized PA solutions. Nearly two years later, Innoviti finally received its PA license.
- ♦ The Reserve Bank of India has taken action against five associate institutions for violation of various bank accounts. These penalties have been imposed on the basis of non-existent deficiencies and the associates' associates with intentions have not been questioned.
- India's current account in the third quarter of 2023-2024 was US\$10.5, which is lower than the previous quarter and the same period last year. Service increased by 5.2%. India's current account balance in the third quarter of fiscal year 2023-2024 showed a deficit of US \$ 10.5 million, which is equivalent to 1.2 percent of GDP. This is less than US\$ 11.4 billion in the previous quarter and less than US\$ 16.8 billion in the same quarter of the last financial year.
- ♦ Lakshmi Narayanan Seshu, a beloved personality of the Tamil entertainment industry, breathed her last at a private hospital in Chennai. The industry's famous comedy actor Lakshmi Narayanan Sheshu née Lolu Sabha Sheshu has passed away.

- S&P Global Ratings estimates US policy rate adjustment norms by RBI to increase the reporate by up to 75 basis points in 2024-2025. Despite steady recruitment and growth, there are expectations of reservation in vacancies. The moves mirror US policy in LCD's studio, which most investors expect to happen by the end of the fiscal year. The agency also expects similar rate adjustments in Indonesia, New Zealand and the Philippines.
- UNESCO, on behalf of UN Water, published the United Nations World Water Development Report 2024. The report highlights that tensions over water are fueling conflict around the world. To maintain peace, countries should promote international cooperation and cross-border agreements.
- The first Global Inequality Research Award was presented to Bina Agarwal and James Boyce. The World Inequality Lab has joined hands with Sciences Po's Center for Research on Social Inequalities to present the first edition of the Global Inequality Research Award. The purpose of this award is to honor researchers from all disciplines who have made significant contributions to the understanding of global inequalities. The Global Inequality Research Prize will be awarded every two years.
- Two streams of stars that helped form our galaxy 12 billion years ago have been discovered by the European Space Agency's telescope Gaia. An unprecedented insight into the history of our galaxy the Milky Way has been gathered by the European Space Agency. The researchers were examining data collected by Gaia when they noticed the currents, which they named Shakti and Shiva.
- Hong Kong lawmakers unanimously passed the National Security Protection Bill. Article 23 of the Basic Law states that the Hong Kong government must freely make laws prohibiting national security crimes.
