#### Current Affairs Related to 26th June 2024

- These were launched by Union Minister for Food Processing Industries Chirag Paswan and Union Minister of State for Food Processing Industries and Railways Ravneet Singh as a precursor to the third edition of World Food India. World Food India will be organized from 19 to 22 September 2024. It will be organized to promote collaboration and partnership between global and Indian food sector stakeholders. World Food India 2023 witnessed 1208 exhibitors, 175 international buyers from 90 countries, 24 states and 75000 attendees.
- Indian superstar Neeraj Chopra added another feather to his cap by winning the gold medal in the Men's Superstar Mahavir Phogat event at the Paavo Nurmi Games 2024 in Turku, Finland. The Paavo Nurmi Games is an important World Athletics Continental Tour prestigious event, and Neeraj's win has further cemented his position in the sport.
- A water repellent catalyst has been developed by a team of scientists from Assam, Odisha, China and the United Kingdom that can significantly reduce the cost of producing eco-friendly biodiesel from current levels. Researchers have developed a spherical superhydrophobic activated carbon catalyst to handle water byproducts during biodiesel production. Their findings have been published in the latest issue of Advanced Functional Materials, a leading materials science journal.
- PM Modi laid the foundation stone of development projects in Jammu and Kashmir. He inaugurated and laid the foundation stone of 84 major development projects worth more than Rs 1500 crore. The projects included projects related to road infrastructure, water supply schemes and infrastructure in higher education etc. Apart from this, the Prime Minister also laid the foundation stone for improvement of Chenani Patnitop Nashri section, development of industrial estate and construction of six government degree colleges.

- ★ Hindustan Aeronautics said the Defense Ministry has issued a request for proposals for 156 light combat helicopters. After that, in intraday trade on BSE, shares of Hindustan Aeronautics rose by 5% to reach a new high of Rs 5484.20.
- A special report prepared by the World Bank and S&P Global Marketing Intelligence for the year 2023 attributes container port convergence significantly to the performance of India's port development programme. In the latest edition of this report, 9 ports of India have made it to the global top 100 ports.
- ♦ The Home Ministry has appointed IAS officer Ashwini Kumar as Commissioner of Delhi Municipal Corporation with immediate effect.


