#### **History of 10th July**

### Current Affairs Related to 10th July 2024

- Laotian officials have discussed preparations for the 57th meeting of foreign ministers of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations and related obligations, scheduled to be held in the Lao capital Vientiane from July 21 to 27. A preparatory meeting was held under the chairmanship of Salimxay Komasith, Deputy Prime Minister and Foreign Minister of Laos. Preparatory work includes accommodation for ministers and dignitaries, vehicles for deputy ministers, transport, communication and internet facilities.
- ♦ A web portal for speedy bank settlement of interest subsidy claims was launched by Union Agriculture and Farmers Welfare Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan. The web portal will automate and expedite the process of settlement of interest subsidy claims submitted by banks under the Agriculture Infrastructure Fund. The newly introduced automation system of loan claims will ensure timely settlement of claims within a day, which otherwise would have taken months for manual settlement. The automated system will help in calculating the exact eligible interest subsidy through the portal.
- CM Mohan Yadav has launched Lokpath mobile app for the public. Chief Minister Dr. Mohan Yadav has said that our aim is to make all the activities as responsive as possible to the public. Lokpath mobile app, which has been prepared by the Public Works Department, is being launched with the aim of moving forward on the path of public welfare. Its objective is to achieve sustained progress by adopting a more inclusive and accountable working system towards the public.
- Sujata Saunik, a PhD officer of 1987 batch, became the first woman Chief Secretary of Maharashtra, breaking a 64-year-old tragedy. Saunik took over from his predecessor Nitin Karrier in the office of the Chief Secretary on the sixth floor of the ministry. He is scheduled to retire in June next year. Chief Minister Eknath Shinde and Deputy Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis have positively appointed Sauniks to the role, indicating support from women voters ahead of the upcoming assembly elections.

- According to Uttar Pradesh, the state government has prepared the draft Uttar Pradesh Natural Investment Zone for Manufacturing Sector Plan 2024. The initiative, headed by Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath, is part of a broader strategy to grow the state's economy to the one billion dollar mark. Sector Plan 2024 is to be set up by Special Investment Zones throughout Uttar Pradesh. According to the plan, these areas will be spread equally across the four geographical regions of the state.
- Indiabulls Housing Finance Limited has undergone a makeover, rebranding itself as Samman Capital Limited. These changes reflect its transformation from a promoter-led entity to a board-driven, diversified financial institution. The regulatory induced re-branding marks an important milestone in the company's 25-year journey since its inception as Indiabulls Finance Services Limited in 2000.




