

History of 27th July

- ◆ **1889** : The British India Committee, a branch of the Indian National Congress, was led by Dadabhai Naoroji, William Wedderburn, WS Cain and William Digby in London.
- ◆ **1897** : Bal Gangadhar Tilak was arrested for the first time.
- ◆ **1982** : Prime Minister Indira Gandhi's first visit to America took place after almost 11 years.
- ◆ **1940** : The famous writer of Indian origin Bharti Mukherjee was born.

Current Affairs Related to 27th July 2024

- ◆ The Department of School Education and Literacy is celebrating Education Week from 22 to 28 July. The main objective of Education Week is to promote collaboration among students, teachers and stakeholders and the educational reforms initiated by the National Education Policy 2020. Education Week is being celebrated in government schools to commemorate the completion of 4 years of the National Education Policy 2020.
- ◆ Prime Minister Narendra Modi announced that India will contribute \$1 million to the UNESCO World Heritage Centre. It will provide support for heritage conservation, particularly in countries of the Global South. This grant will be used for capacity building, technical assistance and conservation of World Heritage sites.
- ◆ UPSC Chairman Manoj Soni has resigned. He has resigned citing personal reasons before the end of his term in May 2029. He had tendered his resignation a fortnight ago. All this remains to be accepted. He took oath as UPSC Chairman on 16 May 2023. His tenure was to end on 15 May 2029.
- ◆ Assam Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma said the Assam Cabinet approved a bill to repeal the Assam Muslim Marriages Divorce Registration Act and Rules, 1935. By passing the Assam Repeal Bill 2024, the government of Assam decided to repeal the Assam Muslim Marriage and Divorce Registration Act and Rules of 1935. The Repeal Bill 2024 will be introduced during the upcoming monsoon session of the Assembly.
- ◆ Noted writer and poet Jukanti Jagannatham has been nominated for the prestigious Sri Dasarathi Krishnamacharya Award for 2024 by the Government of Telangana. The award, which includes Rs 1 lakh in cash and a memento, will be presented to Sri Jagannatham on the occasion of the birth anniversary of Dasharathi Krishnamacharya.
- ◆ Renowned agriculturalist Padyashri Kamla Pujari passed away in Cuttack at the age of 74.
- ◆ LIC joins hands with IDFC First Bank to sell life insurance policies online. This will allow more than 1 crore customers of IDFC First Bank to buy LIC policies online through the bank's website. This agreement is part of efforts to increase the contribution of bancassurance and provide life insurance coverage to all by 2047. The combined strength of LIC's network of over 3600 branches and satellite offices and IDFC First Bank's network of over 1000 branches will help in the spread of life insurance across the country.
- ◆ MoU has been signed for establishment of BIS Standardization Chair Professor. This initiative is an important step towards formally institutionalizing the collaboration of BIS with leading academic and research establishments across India. The objective of the BIS Standardization Chair Professorship is to foster a strong partnership between BIS and IISc to promote collaborative work on standardization and harmonization of product specifications on the principles of equivalence and reciprocity.
- ◆ Union Coal and Mines Minister G. Kishan Reddy launched the National District Mineral Foundation Portal. It is a centralized platform to collect information about District Mineral Foundations across the country. This portal has been launched with the aim of facilitating access to DMF data and tracking its development and usage.
- ◆ Leander Paes and Vijay Amritraj, great Indian tennis players known for their historic wins, have become the first Asian exponents of the game to be inducted into the International Hall of Fame. Their inclusion marks an important milestone in the recognition of Asian athletes in tennis history.
- ◆ The 13th edition of India Chem was launched with the theme Advantage India: Indian Chemicals and Petrochemicals paving the way for the future.




