History of 24th July

- ♦ 1989: 73 Members of the Republican Party in India resigned from the leaders on the issue of Bofors gun.
- ♦ 1911 : India's famous flute player Pannalal Ghosh was born.
- 1991: Finance Minister Manmohan Singh presented the budget in Parliament, which opened the way for economic liberalization for India.
- ♦ 1932 : Ramakrishna Mission Seva Pratishthan was established.

Current Affairs Related to 24th July 2024

- Among mutual funds and portfolio management services, SEBI is planning a new asset class. The gap between mutual funds and portfolio management services will be bridged by the new asset class. This will be provided under the MF framework, with updated branding and relevant MF norm relaxations. It is proposed that the minimum ticket size be Rs 10 lakh, which is equivalent to one-tenth of alternative investment products and one-fifth of PMS schemes. To this extent, retail investors will be discouraged from investing in the product.
- ♦ MV Sea Change 100: The world's first commercial passenger ferry powered by hydrogen, launched at the San Francisco Ferry Building. The 70-foot catamaran can carry up to 75 passengers between Pier 41 and the Downtown San Francisco Ferry Terminal. Unlike current diesel-powered boats that emit pollutants, the hydrogen-powered Sea Change produces only heat and water vapor as byproducts.
- ◆ Maharashtra Government has started the Chief Minister Youth Work Training Scheme for unemployment allowance among the youth. Its objective is to provide valuable internship opportunities to the youth, employ them with the skills they need and achieve their employability in competitive jobs. The government has proposed Rs 5500 crore for this scheme.
- President Draupadi Murmu has returned the Punjab University Law Bill 2023 to the Punjab Government. In this, there is a proposal to make the Chief Minister the Chancellor of the state universities in place of the Governor of Punjab. On December 6 last year, Governor Banwarilal Purohit had reserved three bills passed by the Punjab Assembly for June 2023.
- ◆ India has completed its fourth periodic review by the Citizens' Committee in Geneva and under the International Covenant on Political Rights, demonstrating its comprehensive commitment to the protection and protection of human rights.

- Continuing its endeavor to enhance the contribution of Bank Insurance and offer life insurance to all by 2047, Life Insurance Corporation of India has created Institutional Agency Arrangements under one of the best technologically advanced and hope generating institutions of the country. .IASFC has agreement with First Bank Limited. The alliance was signed. This tie-up will facilitate over 1 crore customers of FC First Bank who now have LLC stock purchase fees through the bank.
- The Asian Development Bank has approved a US\$240.5 million loan to finance rooftop solar power systems in India, providing support to the government to expand energy access through renewable energy. ADB had announced that this fragmented multitranche financing facility would support Stages 2 and 3 of the Solo Rooftop Investment Program, which ADB approved in 2016.
- ♦ INS Delhi was adjudged as the Best Ship in the Eastern Fleet at the Annual Fleet Awards Function 2024 held at Visakhapatnam. The event was organized to acknowledge and celebrate the operational achievements of the Eastern Fleet during the previous year. The Best Ship Award among Corvette/OPV/LST was given to INS Kavaratti.
- The book has compiled 75 important speeches of the first year of President Draupadi Murmu's tenure. This book has been published by the department. Union Agriculture Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan released the e-book in the presence of Information and Broadcasting Minister Ashwini Vaishnay.
- The Space Research Committee, the world's first scientific organization dedicated to space science research, honored two Indian space scientists, Prahlad Chandra Agarwal and Anil Bhardwaj, with prestigious awards. Aggarwal received the Harry Massey Award at the 45th COSPAR Scientific Conference that began in Busan, South Korea.




