History of February 7

- ◆ 1915 : For the first time, a wireless message sent from a moving train was received by the railway station.

Current Affairs Related to 7 February

- Vikarabad district of Telangana is set to host India's second very low frequency communication station by 2027. It is important for naval communications with ships and submarines. The Indian Navy has strategically selected Telangana as the location for its second Very Low Frequency Communication Transmission Station in the country. This significant development is scheduled to take place in Vikarabad district, with the new VLF center scheduled to be completed by 2027.
- Odisha Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik has unveiled plans to set up the world's first black tiger safari near Similipal Tiger Reserve in Mayurbhanj. This visionary project aims to provide tourists and visitors a rare glimpse of melanistic tigers, commonly known as black tigers, which have recently been spotted in Similipal National Park. Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik expressed his excitement over showcasing these majestic creatures and emphasized that this safari would be the only place in the world to see such a unique species.
- ♦ The Petroleum Ministry has approved the formation of a subsidiary by Oil and Natural Gas Corporation Limited dedicated to green energy and gas sector. This important step was announced during ONGC's board meeting, reflecting the company's commitment to diversify its portfolio and contribute to sustainable energy solutions.
- Indian table tennis player Sreeja Akula achieved a significant milestone in her career by clinching her maiden international title at the WTT Feeder Corpus Christi 2024 in Texas, USA. The 25-year-old athlete displayed exceptional skill and determination in the women's singles event.
- Farooq Engineer and Ravi Shastri were honored with the Colonel CK Naidu Lifetime Achievement Award at the Naman Awards ceremony in Hyderabad.

- After Bihar, Andhra Pradesh is conducting a comprehensive caste census, demonstrating its dedication towards understanding and addressing the complex caste dynamics within its population. The ambitious census, launched with the help of a specially designed phone app, aims to enumerate all castes in the state and is expected to be completed within the next 20 days to a month.
- The Government of India, prioritizing the security of global shipping lanes, signed an agreement with Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Limited Mumbai to acquire 14 Fast Patrol Vessels for the Indian Coast Guard. With the cost of freight and shipping rising due to increasing activities of international piracy in the Gulf of Aden, the Government of India has taken an important step to ensure the security of international shipping lanes.
- The Union Cabinet chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi was informed about a Memorandum of Understanding signed between the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology of the Republic of India and the Ministry of Transport, Communications and Information Technology of the Sultanate of Oman on mutual cooperation in the field of Information Technology. The objective of this MoU is to promote comprehensive cooperation between the concerned parties through mutual cooperation, sharing of technologies and information and investment in the field of information technology.
- The Central government has formally announced the appointment of Justice Prasanna B Varale as a judge of the Supreme Court, making him the third judge from the Dalit community to be appointed to the apex court. His appointment adds to the diversity of the apex court and joins Justice BR Gavai and Justice CT Ravikumar. A notable aspect of Justice Varale's appointment is that he is the senior-most High Court judge belonging to a Scheduled Caste.
- India, France and the United Arab Emirates conducted a major air exercise named Desert Night over the Arabian Sea.
