History of 29th February

- ♦ 2004: International Space Station traveler Michel Foyle's Alexander Kelly landed in space, but returned to the station due to a space suit malfunction.
- ♦ 2000: Russian forces occupy 90 percent of Chechnya, Rwandan Prime Minister Pierre Celestin Rwigema resigns from his post.

Current Affairs related to 29th February

- Vietnam has greenlighted an ambitious national theoretical strategy with the goal of producing an estimated 1.000000.5 million tonnes of clean by 2030, which could be increased to 10.20 million tonnes by 2050. Vietnam has formulated an ambitious national scientific strategy, which aims to be a significant player in the global niche market.
- Comoros and Timor Leste became members of the World Trade Organization on the opening day of the 13th WTO Ministerial Conference. The 13th Ministerial Conference of the World Trade Organization is being held in Abu Dhabi from 26 to 29 February 2024. India stressed on flexibilities within existing WTO agreements to address the concerns of developing countries. India highlighted the need to avoid fragmentation of the multilateral trading system and the importance of remaining focused on the WTO agenda rather than non-trade issues.
- ◆ Information and Broadcasting Minister established CBFC Facilitation Office in Chandigarh. Its objective is to promote ease of doing business for filmmakers in the region. This was announced at the closing ceremony of Chitra Bharati Film Festival in Chandigarh. Under this, filmmakers from the region will get the facility to screen and submit cuts/ revisions of their films, without having to go to Delhi or Mumbai to obtain CBFC certificate for their films.
- Dubai government has launched a five-year multiple entry visa for Indian tourists. Dubai's Department of Economy and Tourism has launched this initiative to attract more Indian tourists. Dubai saw a significant growth of 25% in overnight visitors from India in 2023. This five-year multiple entry visa for Indian tourists will deepen economic cooperation, encourage tourism and strengthen trade ties. This new visa will allow tourists to enter the UAE multiple times based on their sponsorship.

- Germany is Europe's largest economy and aims to become carbon neutral by 2045. The German government will allow carbon capture and sub-sea storage technology in some industries. These systems will capture carbon dioxide produced by industrial processes at the point of emission and remove it from the atmosphere. Germany is likely to miss its climate targets and is aiming to capture between 34 million and 73 million tonnes of carbon annually by 2045.
- Ahead of the March 15 deadline to cease business,
 Paytm founder Vijay Shekhar Sharma has resigned
 as part-time non-executive chairman of Paytm Payments Bank Limited. This includes former Central
 Bank of India Chairman Srinivasan Sridhar, retired
 IAS officer Debendranath Sarangi, former Bank of
 Baroda Executive Director Ashok Kumar Garg and
 former IAS officer Rajni Sekhri Sibal.
- In a remarkable display of grit and determination, Bhagwan Singh and Mahesh Prithviraj from Bhopal completed the 2024-sized Pagong Frozen Lake in Leh-Ladakh. World's Largest Frozen Lake Famous for dinosaurs, this prototype is celebrated as the world's largest frozen lake.
- ♦ Four astronauts Prashant Nair, Angad Pratap, Ajit Krishnan and Shubhanshu Shukla have been named for India's first manned space mission. Prime Minister Narendra Modi revealed the names of four astronauts for the Gaganyaan mission.
- Uniform Civil Code, the Assam government decided to repeal the Assam Muslim Marriage and Divorce Registration Act 1935. The state Cabinet approved the Assam Repeal Ordinance 2024 to repeal the British-era Marriage and Divorce Act specific to Muslims. Muslim marriages and divorces will no longer be registered under this Act.
