History of 1st July

- ♦ 1879 : Postcards were introduced in India.
- 1975: The then Prime Minister Indira Gandhi announced 20-point programs for national development.
- ♦ 1997 : The country's first Science City was estab-

lished in Kolkata.

- ♦ 1955 : Imperial Bank of India was nationalized and named State Bank of India.
- ♦ 2017 : Goods and Services Tax was implemented in India as an important reform to the economy.

Current Affairs Related to 1st July 2024

- Madhya Pradesh Government has approved the establishment of a Prime Minister Excellence College in all the districts of the state. Prime Minister's Excellence College will be formally inaugurated in all 55 districts of Madhya Pradesh on July 1. Madhya Pradesh CM Dr. Mohan Yadav said that a drone policy will also be made in the state. CM directed the officials to ensure better education system keeping in mind the increasing employment opportunities in aviation, agriculture and artificial intelligence.
- The Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs has launched Swachh Bharat Mission Urban 2.0, which will be completed from July 1 to August 31, 2024. The initiative aims to strengthen urban local bodies to face the increasing sanitation and health problems during the season. It is aligned with the Stop Diary campaign of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, with emphasis on comprehensive intervention and inter-departmental collaboration.
- ♦ Pat Cummins created history as he became the first player to take 2 hat-tricks in the T20 World Cup. He achieved this feat during the Super 8 match between Australia and Afghanistan in St. Vincent. Cummins achieved this feat by taking the wickets of Rashid Khan, Karim Janat and Gulbadin Naib.
- State Bank of India, under Chairman Dinesh Kumar Khara, targets 400 new attractive investments across India in the financial year 2024-2025. This is part of the major's strategy to enhance customer service, especially in top domains such as wealth management and advisory services, despite the growing trend towards extended digital mouse.
- Smriti Mandhana became the first Indian woman to score two combined centuries in the second ODI against South Africa at the M Chinnaswamy Stadium in Bengaluru. She recorded the record for most runs scored by an Indian woman in a One Day International series.

- Rahul Gandhi will be the leader of opposition in the 18th Lok Sabha. There will be an official LOP again in the Lower House after a gap of 10 years since 2014. This announcement was made by Congress General Secretary KC Venugopal. Rahul Gandhi is MP from Rae Bareli. The leader of the largest opposition party having more than one-tenth of the total number of seats in the Lok Sabha is considered the Leader of the Opposition. He will serve on various committees such as Public Accounts, Undertakings, Estimates and several Joint Parliamentary Committees
- Kenya has been declared by the United States as its major non-NATO ally. According to a memorandum issued by the White House, MNNA recognition is a designation under US law that provides specific benefits to foreign partners in the field of defense trade and security cooperation. According to the US State Department the MNNA designation is a powerful symbol of the United States' close ties with the countries.
- Rohit Sharma became the first player to score 200 runs in the T20 World Cup 2024 Super Eight Group 1 match against Australia at the Darren Sammy National Cricket Stadium in St Lucia. Rohit scored 92 runs in 41 balls and took eight wickets in this innings, taking his total number of sixes in T20 International cricket to 203.
 - A one day International Workshop on Global Navigation Satellite System based Electronic Toll Collection in India was organized by Indian Highway Management Company Limited, an NHAI promoted company, in New Delhi. This workshop was organized to provide a smooth and hassle-free tolling experience to the drivers on National Highways. This international workshop provided a unique platform to both industry and global experts to discuss various aspects related to smooth implementation of free-flow tolling system based on GNSS technology in India.


