## **History of 25th July**

- ♦ 1813 : The first boat race was organized in Calcutta.
- ◆ 1837: The electric telegraph was used for the first time in a successful demonstration.
- ♦ 1987 : Rangaswamy Venkataraman became Nike President of India.
- ◆ 1978: The world's first IVF church, Louise Brown, was born in Oldham, England.
- ◆ 1997: KR Narayan became the tenth President of India.
- ◆ 2017: More than 70 people died due to floods in Gujarat.

## Current Affairs Related to 25th July 2024

- The Ministry of Minority Affairs is organizing Lok Samvardhan Parv as part of the 100 day program to publicize its schemes, programs and achievements. The program will also showcase the activities being carried out in collaboration with partner organizations and highlight success stories under various schemes. On this occasion, Shri Kiren Rijiju also released a plan to provide loan facility of more than Rs. 1 thousand crore by National Minority Development and Finance Corporation to more than 2.5 lakh beneficiaries for the year 2024-2025.
- National Film Development Corporation has joined hands with Netflix India to launch The Voicebox, a skill upgradation program for voice over artistes in India. The Voicebox program will provide recognition of prior learning training for voice over artists, focusing on English, Hindi, Marathi, Bengali, Malayalam, Tamil, Telugu and Gujarati languages. Structured workshops including training will be organized as part of the programme.
- Union Agriculture Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan met Malaysian Minister of Plantations and Commodities Datuk Seri Johari Abdul Ghani in New Delhi. In the meeting they discussed opportunities to deepen bilateral agricultural cooperation between India and Malaysia. They also discussed market access issues related to agricultural and allied products. The ministers also discussed the National Mission on Edible Oils.
- The 9th edition of the Women's Cricket Asia Cup began in Dambulla, Sri Lanka, with Nepal women's team facing off against UAE women's team in the inaugural match. The 9th Women's Asia Cup is being held in the T20 format and all the final matches will be played at the colorful Dambulla International Stadium in Dambulla from 19 to 28 July 2024. The Asian Cricket Council is affiliated with the International Cricket Council, the global cricket governing body.

- Chief Financial Officer Georges Elhedary will become group CEO, according to HSBC Holdings Plc. Elhadary will replace outgoing chief Noel Quinn from September 2. Since 2020, Elhaderi has been co-head of the Global Banking and Markets business, the division that operates HSBC's trade and investment banking advisory businesses. Elhaderi started his career in banking as a rates trader before joining HSBC in 2005.
- The Government of India is likely to sign a Headquarters Agreement with the Global Biofuels Alliance. The diplomatic status and recognition as an international organization of the Global Biofuels Alliance will be similar to that given to the Disaster Resilient Infrastructure Alliance and the International Solar Alliance. After this agreement, the GBA will have an independent and international legal personality which will carry out its functions more efficiently at the international level.
- The R&D roadmap has been prepared after detailed academic scanning of the global automotive sector and identifying future cutting-edge technology requirements. The official launch event of the report was attended by government officials, members of the Advisory Group on e-Mobility, industry and think tank representatives, and members of the press and media. E-mobility and EVs have gained importance among policy makers in India.
- National Film Development Corporation, a public sector enterprise of the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting, has launched The Voicebox, a skilling program for voice over artistes in India. It was attended by Sanjay Jaju, Secretary, Ministry of Information and Broadcasting, Vrinda Mirza, Joint Secretary, Ministry of Information and Broadcasting, Aditya Kutty, Legal Director, Vodafone, Freddy Soames, Head of Concert Policy, Avasar, and Sharad Mehra, President, Pearl Academy, among others.


