



Indian Institute of Management, (IIM-J) Jammu

- Admissions, Eligibility

Indian Institute of Management, Jammu (IIM Jammu) is the twentieth IIM to be established in India. Founded in the year 2016 by Government of India, IIM Jammu is the most recent addition in the IIM family. IIM Jammu is presently running the flagship PGDM (Post Graduate Diploma in Management) course and fellowship program (Ph.D.) in Management. The IIM Jammu faculty focuses on imparting top-notch education in management discipline and fostering quality research.

IIM Jammu also provides Post Graduation courses for working professionals and student exchange programs. The institute has multiple tie ups with prestigious international universities. Currently, IIM Jammu has a temporary campus, situated at Canal Road, Jammu. The proposed permanent campus will be located at Jagati, which is 14 kms away from Jammu City. As for the year 2019, IIM Jammu's intake for the PGDM programme was 140.

IIM Jammu Eligibility

Eligibility For PGDM

- The candidate must hold a bachelor's degree, with at least 50% marks or equivalent CGPA. In case of the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste (SC)/ Scheduled Tribe (ST) and Differently Abled (DA) category, this is relaxed to 45%. The candidate may possess an equivalent qualification recognized by the Ministry of HRD, Government of India.
- Candidates appearing for the final year bachelor's degree / equivalent qualification examination and those who have completed degree requirement and are awaiting results can also apply. The candidate is required to have obtained at least 50% marks or equivalent (45% in case of candidates belonging to SC/ST/DA category) based on latest available grades/marks.

- Candidate should clear CAT. For candidates belonging to open category, the minimum CAT cut off must be above 90%. For SC/ST candidates, the cut off needs to be above 60%

Eligibility for FPM

Either one of the following is required for a candidate to be eligible for FPM

- Candidates must have a Post-Graduation degree in any stream with minimum 60% or equivalent grade point average.

Or

- A professional qualification like CA, ICWA, CS, with at least 50 percent marks.

Or

- Five/Four-year Integrated Post Graduation degree programme in any discipline with minimum 60%, received after higher secondary education (10+2) or equivalent

Or

- A 4-year/8-semester bachelor's degree (BE/ B.Tech) with at least 6.5 CGPA on 10 or equivalent grade point average.
- A candidate must not be above forty years old as on 1 June 2020

Important: Those who will appear for final examination this year may also apply. However, the admission will be granted on provisional grounds subject to submission of required graduation documents before 30th January 2020. Also, the candidate should be possessing at least 50% in 10th and 12th grade or equivalent GPA.

IIM Jammu Admission Procedure

PGDM

The final selections are based on CAT scores, WAT (Written Analysis Test) and finally PI (Personal Interview) Round.

FPM

After meeting eligibility criteria, the candidates need to appear for one of the following examinations:

- CAT
- GRE
- GMAT

- GATE
- JRF-UGC
- CSIR
- UGC-NET

Candidates residing outside can either opt to take any of the above-mentioned tests or apply for GMAT. For the final selection, candidates will be shortlisted based on academic profile and performance in the test for a round of Personal Interview (PI).



Selection Criteria for PGDM at IIM Jammu

The admission process has multiple stages:

- CAT Examination
- Personal Appearance (PA) process includes Written Analysis (WA) and Personal Interview (PI).
- Merit List based on CAT score, PI & WA score and Profile

Criteria for Short listing for WAT-PI process

The cut-off percentile marks for eligibility for PA process in the two sections and the total CAT scores for different categories of students is given below.

- 12th Standard: 3 marks
- Under Graduation: 3 marks

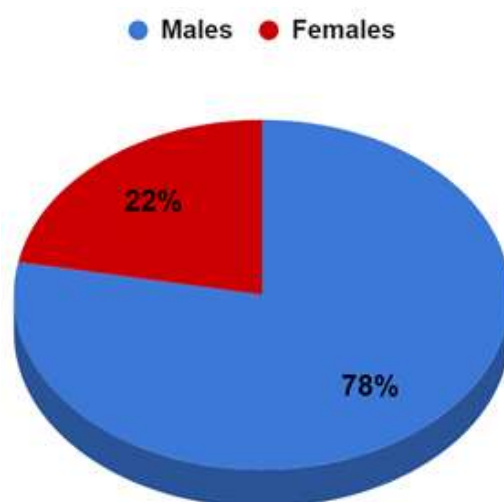

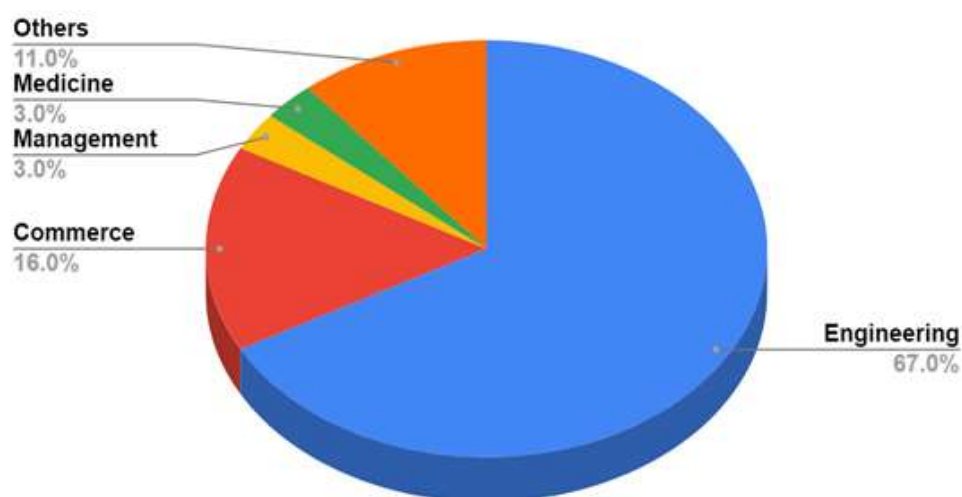

Gender based



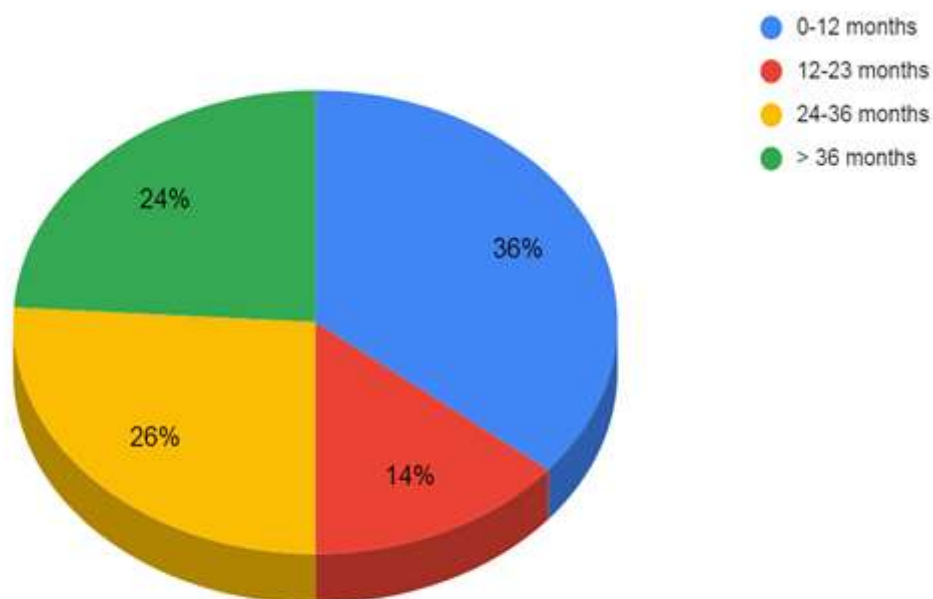
Gender based Diversity - Batch 2018-20

Work Experience Diversity - Batch 2018-20

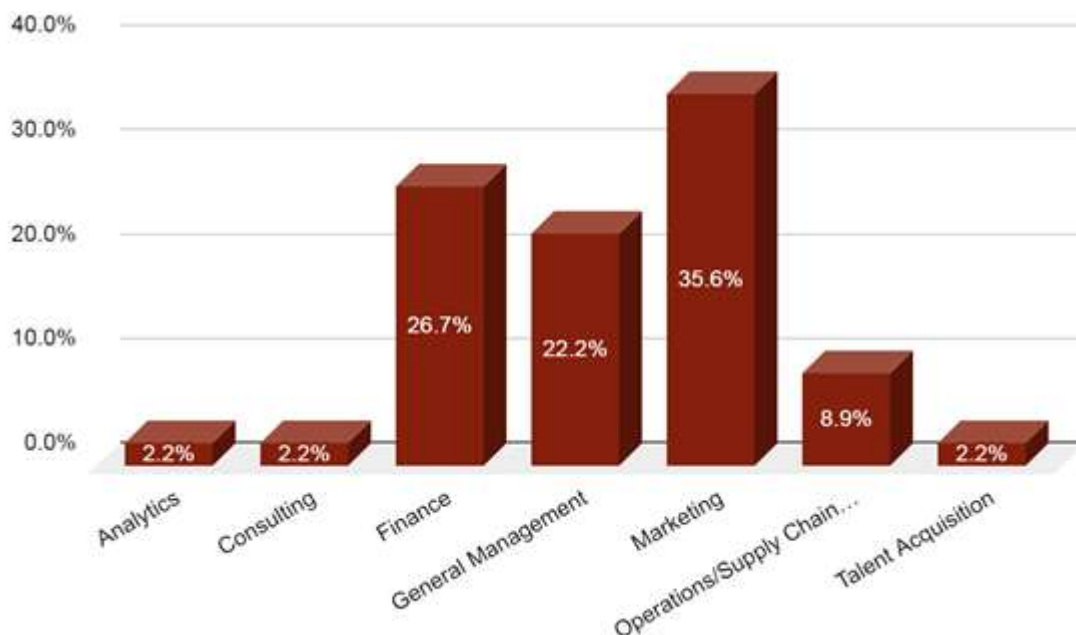
IIM Jammu placements

Now, let us understand the graphical representation of the placement structure of IIM Jammu for the academic session 2018-20

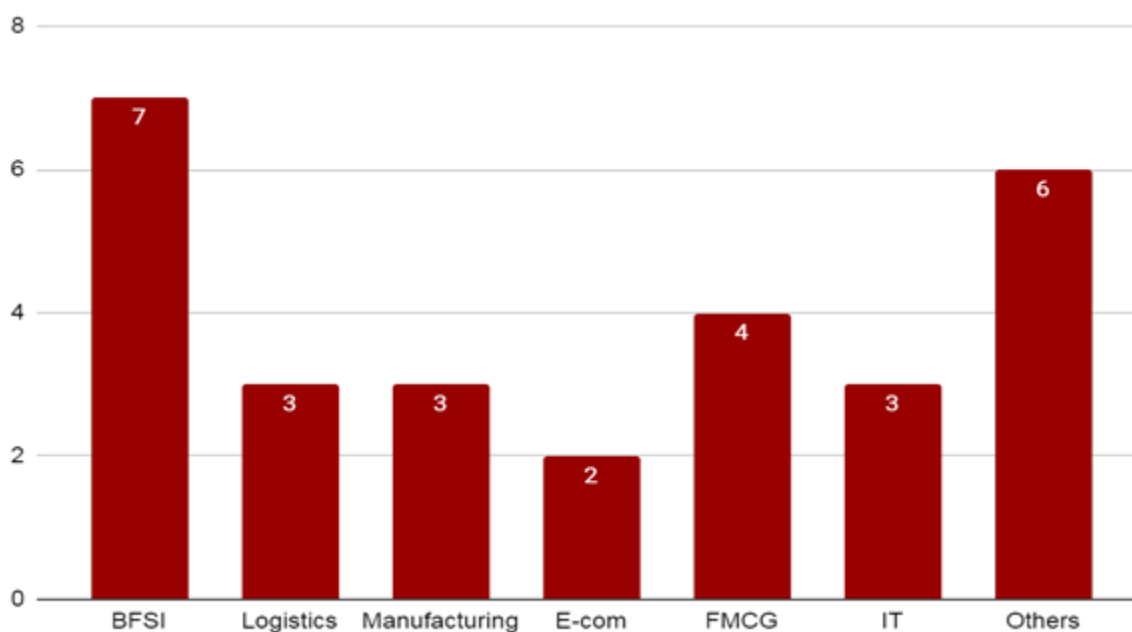


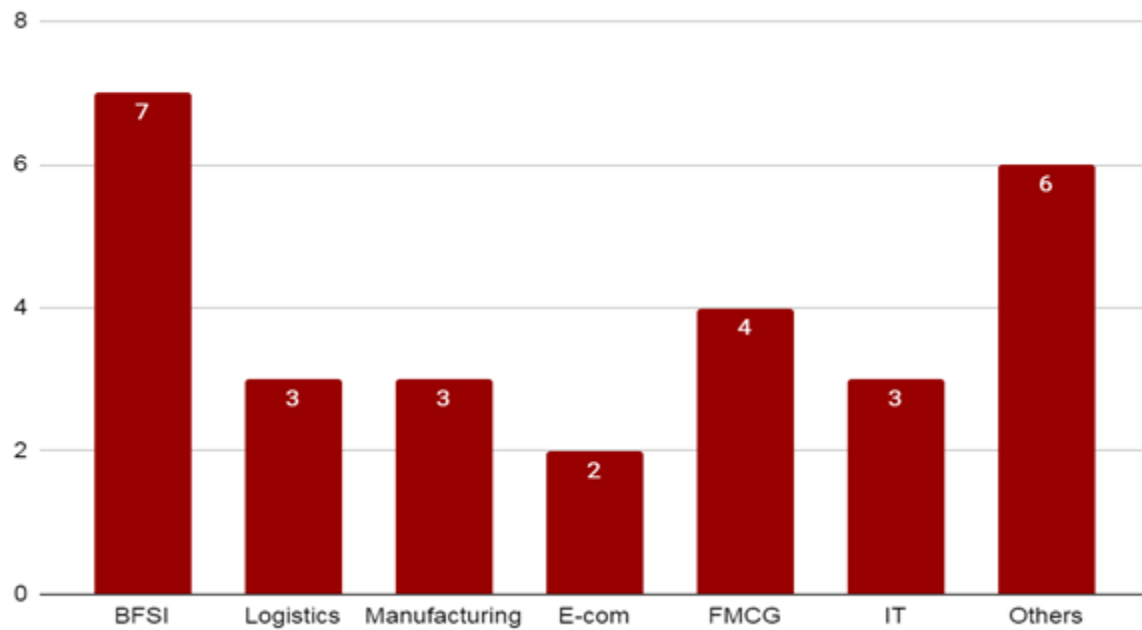
