History of December 21

- ♦ 1898 : Chemists Pierre and Marie Curie discovered radium.
- ◆ 1974: INS Satvahan, the country's first submarine training ship, was commissioned into the fleet at Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh.
- 1952: Saifuddin Kitchlew became the first Indian to receive the Lenin Peace Prize of the then Soviet Union.
- ◆ 1923 : Nepal became a completely independent country after being freed from the status of a British protectorate.

Current Affairs Related to 21 December

- The government is planning to launch a revised incentive scheme of up to Rs 10,000 crore for setting up electronic and semiconductor component plants in the country. This scheme will be a modified version of the scheme to promote manufacturing of electronic components and semiconductors. This scheme is likely to be launched in the next financial year. After Micron got approval to set up an ATMP unit in Gujarat, more subsidiaries are considering setting up associated units. The government will increase the fund to two or three times the current size in the next iteration of the scheme.
- Indian wrestler Final Panghal has been named the Rising Star of the Year among women by the sport's global governing body United World Wrestling. It has been a remarkable season for the 19-year-old dynamo, who competes in the 53 kg category, as she has not only won accolades but also left behind senior veteran Vinesh Phogat in the same weight category.
- Fifteen opposition MPs, 14 from the Lok Sabha and one from the Rajya Sabha, have been suspended from Parliament for irregular conduct in Parliament. Among the suspended MPs, nine are from Congress, two from CPM, two from DMK and one from CPI. Lok Sabha passed a resolution suspending five Congress MPs for the remaining period of the winter session.
- Manish Malhotra designed dresses for the crew members of Air India. After a period of almost six decades, the uniforms of Air India's cabin crew and pilots are being changed. Well-known Indian designer Manish Malhotra has designed these uniforms very well and has given it a new look.
- ♦ Global rating agency Moody's Investors Service recently affirmed the Baa2 rating for Reliance Industries Limited while maintaining a stable outlook. This affirmation reflects RIL's substantial market presence and strong performance across its diverse business areas.

- To increase the firepower of the Indian Army soldiers, the Defense Ministry has approved the proposal to purchase about 6400 rockets for the Pinaka Multi-Barrel Rocket Launcher System. This proposal of Rs 2800 crore has been approved in the recent meeting of the Defense Acquisition Council of the Defense Ministry. In view of the tension on the border, this deal is considered important.
- ◆ Union Minister Arjun Munda inaugurated the ASEAN-India Millet Festival in New Delhi. The main objectives of the festival are to increase awareness and establish a larger market for millets and milletbased products.
- Ruling Congress candidate G Prasad Kumar was elected Speaker of the 3rd Telangana Assembly. Shri Prasad Kumar has been unanimously selected for this prestigious post as no other nominations were filed till the last date for filing nominations ended. He is the first Dalit Speaker of the Telangana Assembly. The new Speaker received the support of 111 MLAs, except eight BJP MLAs, in the 119-member House.
- Scientists from the Department of Atomic Energy and Bengaluru-based IDRS Labs have partnered to develop Actocyte tablets for the treatment of pelvic cancer. Experts from BARC, Tata Memorial Hospital and Advanced Center for Training Research and Education in Cancer collaborated with IDRS Labs with the primary objective of reducing the side effects of radiotherapy. Actocyte tablets have shown remarkable results, especially in pelvic cancer patients suffering from radiotherapy induced cystitis.
- The net direct tax collection of the Government of India in the first eight months of the current financial year i.e. April-November period reached 58.34 percent of the budget estimate. According to the data released by the Finance Ministry, the net direct tax collection during the April-November period reached the level of Rs 10.64 lakh crore.




- 1. Recently, how many more airports will be constructed in Uttar Pradesh in the next two years?
