History of November 30

- ♦ 1759 : Emperor Alamgir II of Delhi was assassinated by his minister.
- 1965 : Dolls Museum, Delhi was established by famous cartoonist K. Shankar Pillai did it.

- 2008 : After the Mumbai terrorist attacks, the government announced the formation of the Federal Investigation Agency. The government decided to extend the tenure of SAT Rizvi Pay Committee.
- 1731: Nearly one lakh people died in the Beijing earthquake.

Current Affairs Related to 30 November

- Mahindra Group CEO Anish Shah is set to become the president of the Indian Federation of Commerce and Industry. He will assume charge in December 2023. Anish Shah is currently the Senior Vice President of FICCI. He will succeed Subhrakant Panda as Chairman after the 96th Annual General Meeting. Anish Shah is the Group CEO of Mahindra Group and Managing Director of Mahindra & Mahindra.
- Robert Shetkintong has been appointed as the High Commissioner of India to the Republic of Mozambique. He is currently serving as the Ambassador of India to Ethiopia since 2020. The ministry said that he is expected to take charge soon. Apart from this, senior diplomat Saurabh Kumar has been appointed India's Ambassador to Belgium. Kumar currently serves as Secretary in the Ministry of External Affairs, and will also be accredited as India's Ambassador to the European Union.
- India and the European Union signed an agreement to build a stronger supply chain and support innovation in semiconductors. The MoU was signed at the EU India Trade and Technology Council meeting. Under this MoU, India and the EU will share experiences, best practices and know-how related to the semiconductor ecosystem. Both sides will identify areas of cooperation in research, development and innovation between universities, research organizations and businesses.
- REC Limited, a Maharatna CPSE under the Ministry of Power, was awarded the Best Employer Award for Policies in Diversity and Inclusion by ASSOCHAM at the 4th Diversity and Inclusion Excellence Awards and Conference. The Best Employer Award for Policies in Diversity and Inclusion reflects REC's commitment to creating a workplace that fosters innovation and promotes equal opportunities for all employees.
- Narendra Modi became the first Prime Minister to fly LCA Tejas.

- The government announced that India will assume the chairmanship of the International Sugar Organization, the apex body for sugar and related products, for 2024. India is the largest consumer and second largest producer of sugar in the world. London-head-quartered ISO has announced the appointment of India as the President of the organization for 2024 in its 63rd Council meeting. Leading the global sugar sector is a major achievement for the country and a reflection of the country's growing stature in the region. Its main goal will be to bring together all the member countries to adopt more sustainable practices in sugarcane cultivation, sugar and ethanol production and better utilization of by-products.
- Ayurveda Gyan Naipunya initiative has been started for doctors working in the field of Ayurveda. Interested eligible Ayurveda practitioners can send expression of interest in the format available on CCRAS website by December 15, 2023.
- Ode was awarded the Best Film among the 75 Creative Minds of Tomorrow held at the 54th IFFI. As part of the Film Challenge, 75 participants were divided into five teams who made short films in 48 hours on the theme Mission Life. The aim of this initiative is to encourage and nurture young creative talents from various fields of film production.
- ♦ WHO has asked China for more data on the respiratory diseases spreading in northern China. China's Presidential Health Commission said the respiratory illness was caused by the lifting of COVID-19 restrictions and the spread of the pathogen. Common bacterial infections are affecting children, including Mycoplasma pneumonia.
- Indian shooter Anish Bhanwala won the bronze medal in the men's 25m rapid fire pistol event at the ISSF World Cup Final 2023 in Doha, Qatar. Aneesh Bhanwala, competing at the Lusail Shooting Range, finished third in the final by scoring 27 out of 35.
