## History of 7th June

- ♦ 1539 : Afghan Shershah Suri defeated Mughal emperor Humayun in the battle of Chausa near Buxar.
- ♦ 1975: The first world match was played between India and England at Lord's Stadium in Lon-

don

- ♦ 1893 : Mahatma Gandhi used civil disobedience for the first time in South Africa.
- ◆ 1979: India's second satellite Bhaskar I was launched from Bears Lake in the Soviet Union.

### Current Affairs Related to 7th June 2024

- The ninth edition of the ICC Men's T20 World Cup is set to be an exciting event, with the winner taking home a record-breaking prize money of at least \$2.45 million. This astonishing prize represents the highest prize money ever in the history of the tournament, making the coveted trophy even more coveted. In addition to the championship glory, the runner-up will receive a significant sum of at least \$1.28 million, while the losing semi-finalists will receive a sum of \$787,500 each.
- Marking the end of an era, senior wicketkeeper batsman Dinesh Karthik announced his retirement from all forms of cricket. The recently concluded Indian Premier League season saw his emotional departure from the Royal Challengers Bangalore franchise. Karthik scored 3463 runs in 180 matches in his international career, which included one Test century and 17 half-centuries.
- The Reserve Bank of India for the first time canceled the auction of 10-year green bond as traders refused to pay premium on it. Dealers gave this information. Greenium refers to the premium investors are willing to pay for their sustainability impact. Moving away from the pattern of issuing green bonds in the next half, the government plans to issue green bonds worth Rs 12,000 crore in the first half of the current financial year.
- Wipro 3D and ISRO join hands for sustainable space exploration through additive manufacturing. Wipro 3D in collaboration with ISRO has developed the PS4 3D printed rocket engine that powers the fourth stage of the Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle. Ch4 engines are traditionally manufactured through conventional machining and welding.
- ♦ The announcement by the Central Government to increase the dearness allowance of its employees from 4% to 50% has led to significant adjustments in various allowances, especially retirement gratuity.

- Railways is planning to build a canopy bridge over the track at Holangapar Gibbon Sanctuary. The Northeast Frontier Railway will build a canopy bridge for the movement of the apes over the railway track that bisects the Holangapar Gibbon Sanctuary in Assam. These canopy bridges will be designed by the Wildlife Institute of India in collaboration with Northeast Frontier Railway. Canopy bridges will be built in such a way that the bridge looks as natural as possible.
- Scientists have developed a way to produce noninfectious Nipah virus-like particles in the laboratory. Scientists at the Institute of Advanced Virology, Thonnakkal have developed a way to generate non-infectious Nipah virus-like particles in the laboratory. This new method provides an alternative, safe and effective platform to develop neutralizing antibodies against Nipah virus in a biosafety level-2 laboratory.
- Adani International Ports Holdings Private Limited, a wholly owned subsidiary of Adani Ports and Special Economic Zone, signed a 30-year concession agreement with Tanzania Ports Authority. The agreement will enable AIPH to operate and manage Container Terminal 2 at the Port of Dar es Salaam in Tanzania.
- According to government data, India received the highest FDI from Singapore in 2023-2024. Due to global economic uncertainties, FDI inflows into India have declined by about 3.5%. Mauritius, Singapore, USU in FY 2024 There was a decline in FDI equity inflows from countries like UAE, Cayman Islands, Germany and Cyprus.
- ♦ The National People's Party won five seats. The Conrad Sangma-led NPP is part of the NDA alliance. People's Party of Arunachal won two seats and NCP won three seats.
