History of February 1

- ♦ 1827 : Calcutta Bengal Club was established.

Current Affairs Related to 1 February

- PepsiCo India has appointed Jagrat Kotecha as its new CEO in place of Ahmed Al Shaikh as part of a strategic makeover. Kotecha, who is currently PepsiCo's chief commercial officer for Africa, Middle East and South Asia, is set to take over the reins of PepsiCo India operations in March 2024. The move comes as Ahmed Al Sheikh changes his role as CEO. With over three decades of experience at PepsiCo, Jagrut Kotecha has contributed significantly to the growth of the company.
- In an important step towards sustainable development, the United Nations Development Program and the European Union have allocated a total of more than US\$420,000 to support initiatives aimed at combating deforestation, improving food and nutrition security and adapting to the impacts of climate change. These grants are set to benefit communities in six districts of Enga Province, Papua New Guinea.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated Boeing's state-of-the-art Global Engineering and Technology Center campus near Bengaluru. The Boeing India Engineering and Technology Center campus, located at the Hi-Tech Defense and Aerospace Park in Devanahalli, marks a significant investment of Rs 1,600 crore, making it Boeing's largest venture outside the United States. These initiatives are designed to facilitate the entry of more girls from across India into the emerging aviation sector.
- ♦ In a significant step on the sidelines of the annual meeting of the World Economic Forum, India has unveiled the Alliance for Global Good Gender Equity and Equality. The initiative has received support from influential institutions, with the World Economic Forum and Invest India joining as key partners.
- Conversations with Aurangzeb is a novel by Tamil writer Charu Nivedita, which has been translated into English by Nandini Krishnan.

- In a significant development towards revolutionizing India's agricultural landscape, a tripartite MoU has recently been signed between the National Farmers Welfare Program Implementation Society, IndiaAI and the Wadhwani Foundation. This collaborative effort aims to take India to the forefront of AI-driven digital agriculture by leveraging the expertise and support of the Wadhwani Foundation in designing and implementing a robust AI strategy.
- Carlos Sainz has created history by winning the Dakar Rally for the fourth time at the age of 61. His latest victory in the 2024 rally marks him as the oldest winner of the grueling race. Sainz, also known as El Matador, is renowned for his extraordinary skill and stamina in one of the world's most challenging motorsport events.
- Unveiled by LIC Chairman Siddharth Mohanty, the new Jeevan Dhara II plan offers a non-participating, individual savings, deferred annuity option. This plan provides life cover during the deferment period and claims higher annuity rates at older ages.
- In a significant progress towards its ambitious target of becoming a US\$ 1 trillion economy, Maharashtra Chief Minister Eknath Shinde announced the signing of 19 MoUs during his visit to the World Economic Forum annual meeting in Davos. Flanked by Industries Minister Uday Samant and senior officials, Shinde expressed his determination to take the state towards economic prosperity.
- Mishra has taken an important step forward in a historic initiative for sustainable energy and environment protection. The Ministry of Tourism and Antiquities, represented by the Supreme Council of Antiquities, in collaboration with the Center for Industrial Modernization in Egypt and the United Nations Development Programme, at a ceremony at the Maniyal Palace.
