Indian History of 20th March

- ♦ 1351 : Sultan Mohammad bin Tughlaq of Delhi died.
- ♦ 1739 : Nadishah captured the Delhi Sultanate.
- ◆ 1904 : C.F. Andrews joined the independence movement with Mahatma Gandhi.
- ♦ 2010 : World Sparrow Day was celebrated for the first time in the name of Gauraiya.
- **2014**: India's famous journalist, writer, novelist and historian Khushwant Singh passed away.

Current Affairs Related 20th March 2024

- The Tamil Nadu government has decided to sign an MoU with the Union Ministry of Education to implement the Sree School Scheme in the state. This information has been given by the Tamil School Education Department. The consent will be signed by the state government before the start of the 2024-2025 academic session. Under the scheme more than 14500 SSLC soldiers will be selected as SRI School. Central Government, State Government, Central UP Pradesh and Local Bodies are eligible for Shree School Scheme.
- ♦ Startup Mahakumbh is being organized in New Delhi. It will continue till 20 March 2024 at Bharat Mandapam. It will have pavilions on AI, B2B, Agritech, Deeptech, Climate Tech, Fintech, Gaming, eSports, Incubators and Accelerators. The event aims to connect startups with venture capitalists, investors and potential corporate partners. More than 2000 startups, 30000 prospective entrepreneurs and 50000 business visitors and more than 500 incubators and delegations from ten countries will participate in the event.
- Sheetal Devi has been declared by the Election Commission as its National Persons with Disabilities Icon. His name was announced in an exhibition cricket match between the Indian Deaf Cricket Association team and the Delhi and District Cricket Association team. The match was held in Delhi and organized by the Election Commission. The Election Commission organized the match in collaboration with the Board of Control for Cricket in India to promote voter education and inclusivity.
- ♦ Vladimir Putin has won the Russian presidential election for the fifth time. He received another six-year term with 87 percent of the vote. Other candidates got less than 5 percent of the votes. Communist candidate Nikolai Kharitonov came second and Vladislav Davankov came third.

- New Zealand's Rachin Ravindra became the youngest recipient of the Sir Richard Hadlee Medal. He also received the Best Male Cricketer of the Year award in New Zealand.
- The global industry is witnessing a significant shift from China to India, with rights recognized by major applicants, protectionism and major trade decisions involving various factor responsibilities. What may be a loss in China's toy manufacturing sector is proving to be a profitable deal for India. India's toy industry has grown rapidly between FY15 and FY23 with a massive growth of 239 per cent in participants.
- The country's first oil palm plant has started in the United States under Mission Palm Oil. 3F Oil Palm, one of the largest oil palm companies in the country, has been established. This plant has been established in Roing in Dibang Valley of Arunachal Pradesh. The direction of self-reliance in edible oils is an important achievement. This is an oil palm plant. Both palm oil company and refining facilities are available in it.
- ♦ In the final match of the Women's Premier League 2024, RBC defeated Delhi Capitals and won the title. The women's RCB team created history by ending the franchise's 16-year trophy streak. The final match of the Women's Premier League was played between Royal Challengers Bangalore and Delhi Capitals. This match between the two teams was played at Aruna Stadium in Delhi.
- With the announcement of the election schedule by the Election Commission of India, the Model Code of Conduct has been implemented to ensure recruitment of clerks in the world's largest democracy.
- ▶ India's position in DHL Global Connectedness shares is estimated to rise significantly, reflecting its majority role in the global industry. From 67th position in 2022, India has reached 62nd position in 2023, which is increasing its importance in the Vaishya sector. India moved up to 62nd position in the DHLConnectedness rankings for 2023, a significant improvement from 67th position in 2022.


