History of January 20

- ◆ 1957 : After India imposed economic sanctions, South Africa announced that it would not provide facilities to Indian ships.
- ♦ 1817 : Hindu College was established in Calcutta.
- ◆ 2006: Nepal and India extended the period of transit treaty by 3 months.
- ♦ 1971 : Mizoram and Arunachal Pradesh emerged as union territories.

Current Affairs Related to 20 January

- The International Labor Organization has released a report named World Employment and Social Outlook Report 2024. ILO claimed in its report that the global unemployment rate is expected to increase to 5.2 percent in the year 2024. According to the study, the labor market outlook and unemployment are expected to worsen, and an additional 2 million workers are expected to seek employment in 2024. The International Labor Union makes rules to protect the interests of laborers and workers on an international basis. It is a specialized organization of the United Nations.
- The definition of people with political influence has been changed by the Reserve Bank of India. This move will make it easier for these people to carry out various banking transactions including obtaining loans. RBI has made some changes in Know Your Customer rules. Earlier criteria for PEPs were simple and lacked clarity on definition. PEPs were facing difficulties in obtaining loans or opening bank accounts.
- A bilateral Haj Agreement 2024 was signed between India and the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. The agreement was signed in Jeddah between Union Minister Smriti Zubin Irani and Saudi Minister of Hat and Umrah Affairs Dr. Tawfiq bin Fauzan Al Rabia. Of these, 1,40,020 seats are reserved for pilgrims through Haj Committee of India, which will benefit first-time Haj pilgrims in 2024. 35,005 pilgrims will be allowed to proceed through Haj group operators.
- The counter drone system developed by DRDO is production ready and has been demonstrated to the armed services and other internal security agencies with some orders already placed. DRDO is now focusing on high-end unmanned aerial vehicles, while the industry has capabilities in small drones. DRDO is creating drone based systems and anti drone systems based on the requirements of user agencies.

- The Central Government has nominated IAS officer Senthil Pandian C as the Ambassador to the World Trade Organization in Geneva. The appointment follows the conclusion of Brajendra Navneet's tenure as India's Ambassador to the WTO on March 31, 2024.
- The Government of Maharashtra has established an important new wildlife habitat in Sangli district, aptly named the Atpadi Conservation Reserve. Spread over 9.48 sq km, this reserve gives priority to the protection of the endangered canid family including wild dogs, wolves, jackals and foxes. Strategically located, Atappadi bridges the distance between the Maini Conservation Area and Madhok Bird Sanctuary, thereby promoting a protected wildlife corridor.
- West Bengal Chief Minister Banerjee has launched a comprehensive social welfare scheme called Yogashree. The initiative aims to provide free training modules for SC and ST students in West Bengal, specifically targeting entrance and competitive examinations. This step has been taken ahead of the Lok Sabha elections, which shows the government's commitment towards educational empowerment. Yogashree scheme involves the establishment of fifty training centers across the state.
- ♦ Under the leadership of Secretary of State Antony Blinken, the US has designated China, North Korea, Pakistan and others as countries of particular concern for serious religious freedom violations. This decision is consistent with the International Religious Freedom Act of 1998, which emphasizes the commitment to advance freedom of religion globally.
 - Mulugu district of Telangana has become the stage of an unexpected archaeological revelation. After a natural disaster a team of amateur historians found a collection of Palaeolithic quartzite tools that has not only enthralled the local community but has also pushed back the understanding of human community in Telangana and Central India.
