- ♦ 2010: The Indian Navy began the process of designing a new light utility helicopter to replace the aging Hoyan Chetak helicopters.
- 2005 : Indian saint Swami Ranganathananda passed away.
- ◆ 1982 : Color broadcast on television started for the first time in Delhi.
- ♦ 1957 : Nuclear reactor: Nuclear reactor was produced for the first time.

Current Affairs Related to 25 April

- Airtels Bank has launched HDFC aligned debit and citizenship cards powered by RuPay, its NPCI affiliate. These cards are designed to support India's One Nation, One Card initiative. Savings account holders can avail NCMC enabled debit cards, while consumer account holders can opt for NCMC enabled debit cards.
- Nigeria has become the first nation to introduce the innovative Men5CV vaccine, targeting five strains of meningococcal that have been registered by the World Health Organisation. This historical milestone is a serious threat in meningitis. The vaccine rollout, funded by Gavi, is an important step towards achieving the goal of eliminating meningitis by 2030.
- The Higher School of Economics based in Russia and Delhi University signed an agreement on strategic cooperation and joint work. They will also operate a large research hub in New Delhi. Its operation will start in the partner university of India. HSE University is a national research university located in Moscow, Russia.
- Gautam Badani led Adani family has invested Rs 8339 crore in Ambuja Markets Limited, increasing their stake to 70.3%. This investment is part of a larger strategy aimed at boosting Ambuja's growth trajectory and strengthening its market position. Adani family's total investment is Rs 20,000 crore, their wealth is linked to Ambuja projects.
- An extraordinary cross between reality and artificial beauty is set to see the world's first beauty pageant featuring handpicked models and gorgeous people. Miss Architecture judged these derivative creations based on how they stood against each other, their online presence aesthetics and the technical prowess behind their creation.

- The world's first Miss AI competition will be held to select the winner based on beauty and social media influence. Models and influencers created through artificial intelligence will compete in the Miss AI beauty pageant. The prize for the competition will be \$20,000. This is the world's first AI beauty pageant and contestants will be judged based on their looks, online stature and the technical skills used to create them.
- ♦ GMR Hyderabad International Airport Limited has been awarded the Best Airport Staff 2024 award in India and South Asia by Skytrax. It was announced to take place during the Passenger Terminal Expo 2024 in Frankfurt, Germany. It honors distinguished service rendered by air defense personnel on various fronts, which is assessed through ratings and evaluation.
- Department for supplying missile applied goods to Pakistan's ballistic missile programme. China, Pakistan's all-time ally, has been the main supplier of arms and defense equipment to Islamabad's military modernization programme. Sanctions have been imposed on China-based Xi'an Longde Technology Development Co. Ltd., Tianjin Creative Source International Trade Co. Ltd. and Granpect Co. Ltd.
- ◆ India handed over the first picture of Brahos missile to China's neighboring country Philippines. The Philippines dumped it in the South China Sea, raising China's concerns. There is controversy over the Philippines' Sparkly Island in the South China Sea.
- Indian Army Chief General Manoj Pendej had gone on a visit to Uzbekistan. During this, he also inaugurated the high technology IT class at the Uzbekistan Armed Forces Academy.
