History of 9th July

- ♦ 1875 : India's first stock exchange, Bombay Stock Exchange, was established.

Current Affairs Related to 9th July 2024

- South Asia's largest flying school will be set up in Amravati by Air India. This school will strengthen the pilot training capacity available in India. Recently the runway of Amravati Airport was expanded by the state-owned Maharashtra Airport Development Company. The flying school will be operational by mid-2026 and will graduate 180 commercial pilots every year. This is the first school to be opened by any Indian airline in the country, which will have 31 single engine and 3 twin engine aircraft for training.
- ✓ Indian Air Force Chief Air Chief Marshal VR Choudhary has inaugurated the Weapon Systems School in Hyderabad. The objective of the WSS is to reorganize the Indian Air Force with a view to the future and modify it with time. According to a statement issued by the Air Force, the formation of this new training institute is a big leap for the armed forces in general and the Indian Air Force in particular. The Weapon Systems School will prepare officers of the newly formed branch as per the requirements of the Indian Air Force.
- An MoU has been signed between the National Informatics Center and the Spices Board of India. This MoU has been signed to develop artificial intelligence tools to detect and classify diseases of large cardamom in Sikkim. The project is being led by the Center of Excellence in AI of NIC in Kolkata. The objective of this project is to identify diseases early by analyzing images of cardamom leaves.
- ◆ Dr.B.N. Gangadhan has been appointed chairman of the National Medical Commission. He previously served as the Chairman of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board. Dr. Sanjay Bihari is the Director of Sree Chitra Tirunal Institute for Medical Sciences and Technology, Thiruvananthapuram. - Niti Aayog launched Sampoorta Abhiyan. This is a 3-month campaign running from 4th July to 30th September 2024. A sustained effort is being launched in the form of this campaign to achieve saturation of six key indicators in aspirational districts and six key indicators in aspirational blocks. Sampurna Abhiyaan under the Aspirational District Program and Aspirational Block Program aims to achieve saturation in each of the six selected indicators in 112 Aspirational Districts and 500 Aspirational Blocks. Blocks and districts will make a three-month action plan to fully implement the six key performance indicators.
- The Ministry of Information and Broadcasting issued a new advisory to advertisers and advertising agencies for advertisements related to food and health sector. Advertisers and advertising agencies will have to upload annual self-declaration certificate for advertisements related to food and health sector. As per the instructions, it will be the responsibility of the advertisers/advertising agencies to comply with the applicable Indian laws.
- A \$170 million policy-led loan was signed by the Government of India and the Asian Development Bank to strengthen India's health system preparedness and response capacity to future pandemics. Ms. Juhi Mukherjee, Joint Secretary, Department of Economic Affairs, on behalf of the Government of India, and Ms. Mio Oka, Director, ADB's India Resident Mission, on behalf of ADB, signed the Strong and Scalable Action for Strengthening and Transformative Health Systems Program.
- India's Under-23 wrestling team performed brilliantly in Amman, Jordan, winning a total of 19 medals in women's wrestling, Greco-Roman and freestyle. Women wrestlers showed dominance in their respective years and won three gold medals. Meenakshi, Pushpa Yadav and Priya Malik performed brilliantly and won in various ways including Vijay getting superiority and Vijay getting fall.


