History of 16th June

- ◆ 1606: During the reign of Jahangir, Guru Arjun Dev was severely tortured and killed in Lahore (Pakistan).
- ♦ 2007: Sunita Williams became the woman to spend the longest continuous period in space.
- ◆ 1858: The Battle of Morar was fought in 1858 during the First Indian War of Independence.
- ◆ 1925 : Great freedom fighter Chittaranjan Das passed away.
- ♦ 1857 : The battle of Morar ended.

Current Affairs Related to 16th June 2024

- Portugal is planning to revamp its Golden Provident Fund scheme to allow wealthy foreigners with residence rights to invest in affordable housing or holiday accommodation for locals. Golden Build is a program that provides residence to wealthy foreigners who purchase real estate. After a decade the program has attracted billions of euros of investment, but it has also fueled a housing crisis for its citizens.
- The ICC T-20 World Cup 2024 includes 20 teams, which are divided into five groups. The top two teams from each group will advance to the eight stage, where they will be divided into four groups of four. Two teams from each of the Super Eight groups will advance, followed by a final match to celebrate the champion's birthday.
- Rajasthan Chief Minister Bhajanlal Sharma has announced an important scheme, under which Maharana Pratap Tourism Circuit will be developed with an investment of Rs 100 crore. The announcement was made on June 8, 2023, during the inauguration of Maharana Pratap Jayanti celebrations in Udaipur, where the 484th birth anniversary of the famous Maharana Pratap of Mewar was celebrated.
- The Indian Army started by developing a technology based innovation, an integrated generator monitoring, protection and control system. Vidyut Rakshak, developed by the Army Design Bureau, was launched by Deputy Chief of Army Staff Lieutenant General Upendra Dwivedi. Electrical protectors are an Internet of Things-enabled generator monitoring, protection and control system.
- ♦ The United Nations Food and Agriculture Organization has released the State of the World Fisheries and Aquaculture 2024, which provides a comprehensive analysis of the global and regional status and trends of fisheries and aquaculture. This report shows that for the first time in 2022, aquaculture production will surpass that of fisheries.

- SBI empowered to get away with Rs 2030 crore in co-lending effort. In an independent move to widen its lending ambit, State Bank of India has tied up with 23 Non-Banking Finance Companies/Housing Finance Companies. Through this collaboration, Singhvi has issued loans totaling Rs 2,030 crore to more than 2.79 lakh borrowers, according to the bank's latest annual report.
- ♦ Bank of India has contributed Rs 6.125 crore in IFSC clearing, with an aim to increase its trust presence in GIFT City IFSC. These acquisitions reflect the Bank's commitment to develop GIFT City as a global financial hub. A real-time foreign exchange settlement system promoted by Clearing House of India Limited is set to operate and act as a clearing house in GIFT City.
 - Indian Revenue Service officer Inderpal Singh Bindra will soon take over as Secretary of the Indian Commerce Commission. Bindra will replace IRS officer Anupama Anand, who has retired within eight months of joining on a regular basis. Bindra's tenure at the CCI is fixed for a period of three years from the date he assumes charge. CCI has been mandated to monitor and curb informal business scenario while promoting an environment of fair competition.
- India expanded foreign port operations. India has set its sights on managing Mangal Port in Bangladesh in an aggressive move to counter China's growing influence in the region. After the successes of Chabahar in Iran and Sittwe in Myanmar, India wants to enhance and strengthen its commercial and security by expanding its foreign port operations.


