### History of 11th July

- ♦ 1987: The world population reached the figure of five billion. The United Nations had decided to celebrate it as Population Day.
- ♦ 2006 : People were killed in bomb blasts in Mumbai.
- ♦ 2003 : Dosti bus started operating from Lahore and Sada-e-Sarhad bus from Delhi.
- ♦ 1902: India's famous freedom fighter, personality and first Defense Minister Sardar Baldev Singh was born.

### Current Affairs Related to 11th July 2024

- Guidelines for funding for testing facilities, infrastructure and institutional support for development of standards and regulatory framework under NGHM have been issued by the Centre. According to the Ministry of New and Renewable Energy, this scheme will be implemented at a total budgetary outlay of Rs 200 crore by the financial year 2025-2026. The scheme will be implemented by the National Institute of Solar Energy. The scheme will assist in identifying gaps in the existing testing infrastructure for parts, technologies and processes making up the value chain of green hydrogen and its derivatives.
- Governments of Madhya Pradesh and Rajasthan signed an MoU for the implementation of Parvati Kalisindh Chambal River Linking Project at a cost of Rs 72,000 crore. The objective of the Parvati, Kalisindh, Chambal river linking project is to provide drinking water and industrial water in 13 districts of eastern Rajasthan and Malwa and Chambal regions of Madhya Pradesh. It will provide water to at least 2.8 lakh hectare area in both the states.
- According to a study published in The Lancet Planetary Health journal, the number of deaths due to air pollution in India is higher even in cities which were previously considered to have relatively clean air. The report found that of the 33,000 deaths annually due to air pollution in the 10 cities surveyed, a significant portion were recorded in coastal centers such as Bangalore, Chennai, Kolkata and Mumbai, where air quality is considered moderate.
- Chemicals and Petrochemicals Secretary Nivedita Shukla Verma inaugurated the conference and exhibition. It is a platform for start-ups, environmental experts and industry leaders to showcase their latest advances. - An MoU was signed by the Indian Register of Shipping and the Indian Institute of Technology Bombay to advance maritime security through the development of ship trajectory prediction tools.
- Bihar government has decided to offer Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery programs in Hindi. This makes Bihar the second state after Madhya Pradesh to offer such a degree. State Health Minister Mangal Pandey announced that medical students will have the option to study MBBS in Hindi from the upcoming academic session. The government has taken this historic step after thorough deliberations on essential aspects including the availability of Hindi textbooks for the MBBS course.
- Scientists have discovered artwork depicting three human-like figures interacting with a wild boar on the ceiling of a limestone cave on the Indonesian island of Sulawesi. Researchers have used a new scientific approach to determine the minimum age of paintings inside the Leang Karampuang cave. This painting is the oldest cave painting in the world, dating back at least 51,200 years.
- RBI has imposed a total fine of Rs 1.32 crore on Punjab National Bank. Along with Know Your Customer, fine has been imposed for violating the rules related to loans and advances. PNB had given working capital demand loans to two companies owned by the state government. These loans were given against the amount received from the government in the form of subsidy, refund or reimbursement.
- ♦ Jharkhand Mukti Morcha working president Hemant Soren took oath as the Chief Minister for Jharkhand. Governor CP Radhakrishnan administered the oath of office and secrecy to Mr. Soren at a ceremony held at Raj Bhavan. He was sworn in as chief minister of the state for the third time, days after the High Court released him on bail in the Kathim money laundering case.


