History of 12th March

- ♦ 1922 : Mahatma Gandhi was arrested by the British during a movement to make goods in Europe and work against British rule.
- ◆ 1954 : The Government of India inaugurated the Sahitya Akademi.
- ♦ 1872: Sher Ali, the murderer of the unrealized Lord Mayo of India, was hanged.
- ♦ 1930 : Mahatma Gandhi started the Dandi March from Sabarmati Ashram.

Current Affairs Related to 12th March

- Jal Shakti Abhiyan: Catch the Rain-2024 campaign has been launched by Union Minister Gajendra Singh Shekhawat. This campaign will be run till 30 November 2024. It has been launched to recognize and appreciate the role of women in water management, conservation and sustainability. The campaign includes water conservation and rain water harvesting, census, geo-tagging and inventory of all water bodies. The campaign includes setting up Jal Shakti Kendras in all the districts, intensive afforestation, and creating awareness among the public.
- With advances in artificial intelligence technology, its energy intensive operation raises serious environmental concerns. Despite these challenges, advanced advances such as spiking neural networks and lifelong learning may provide promising pathways to reducing the carbon footprint of AI with the potential to address the impacts of climate change.
- The National Council of Educational and Research Training has introduced an innovative composite card, which will measure the progress of interpersonal relationships, introspection, creativity and emotional applications, in addition to the child's academic performance in the classrooms. It is a novel approach to evaluating the academic performance of students which is different from the traditional reliance on marks or grades. Instead it is based on a comprehensive assessment system that focuses on various aspects of the student's development and learning experience.
- ↑ The Indian Prime Minister laid the foundation stone for the second rocket launchport of the Indian Space Research Organization at Kulasekarapattinam, Tamil Nadu. Opening up the space sector to private companies is expected to significantly increase commercial launches. This increase in demand could potentially impact existing launch facilities like the Satish Dhawan Space Center in Sriharikota.

- Scientists have sequenced the genomes of 10,000 Indians from different communities to create a database for gene-based treatments.
- Nepal's PhonePe payment service and NPCI International Payments signed an agreement. This agreement will facilitate QR code based, person-to-merchant UPI transactions between India and Nepal. In the first phase, Indian consumers will be able to make UPI payments from business stores in Nepal to merchants on the PhonePe network. PhonePe is a payment system operator. It is a subsidiary of Th1Soft Group.
- India took an important step in the coal sector by launching an initiative called Coal Logistics Plan and Policy which aims to modernize coal transportation. Challenges often arise in transportation of coal due to which Indian Railways needs to implement special measures to resolve the disruption in coal supply. The objective of the Coal Logistics Plan and Policy is to enhance coal logistics by making it more affordable, efficient and environment friendly.
- ♦ Sudha Murthy serves as the chairperson of the Murthy Trust and is also the author of several books. Murthy is the wife of Infosys co-founder N R Narayana Murthy. He received the Padya Shri Award in 2006 and the Padya Bhushan Award in 2023. Murthy started her career as a computer scientist and engineer at Tata Engineering and became the first woman engineer to be appointed at Tata Engineering and Locomotive Company.
 - The National Creators Awards are an effort to honor company excellence and its impact in advocating social change, environmental sustainability, education and gaming, among other areas. The National Creators Awards has seen exemplary public participation. In the first round, more than 1.5 lakh nominations were received in 20 different categories. Following this, around 10 lakh votes were cast for digital creators in various award categories in the voting round.
