History of 15th April

- ◆ 1895 : Bal Gangadhar Tilak inaugurated the Shivaji Utsav at Raigarh Fort.
- 1923 : Insulin became available in the market for people suffering from diabetes.
- ♦ 1994: The letter GATT was used by 109 countries including India.
- ♦ 2004 : LTTE militant V Muraleedharan, linked to the Rajiv Gandhi assassination, was assassinated in Colombo.
- ◆ 1948: The state of Himachal Pradesh was established.

Current Affairs Related to 15th April 2024

- Former Indian hockey player and Dronacharya Award winner Harendra Singh has been selected by Hockey India as the coach of the senior national women's hockey team. According to media reports, he will be appointed coach for the 2028 Los Angeles Olympics. Harendra Singh replaces Hollande's Janneke Shopmap Janneke Shopman, a former Dutch hockey player, stepped down as national women's team coach last month after the Indian team failed to qualify for the Paris Olympics 2024.
- India's largest power company NTPC Limited is preparing to unveil a new edition of its flagship corporate social responsibility initiative, Association Mission. This program has been started by the Government of India under the Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao campaign. The aim of GEM is to eliminate the gendered world by harnessing the imagination of girls and promoting their abilities to explore opportunities.
- After Chabahar port in Iran, India has secured the rights to operate its second foreign port in Sittwe, Myanmar. A proposal by India Ports Global to take over the operations of the entire port located on the Kaladan River has been approved by the Ministry of External Affairs. India Ports Limited is a joint venture between Deendayal Port Trust and Jawaharlal Nehru Port Trust.
- ♦ The Supreme Court said that candidates contesting elections are not required to disclose every movable property owned by them or their dependents. The court said that candidates will have to disclose information about assets that are of substantial value or represent a luxurious lifestyle.
- Harendra Singh was appointed as the coach of Indian women's hockey after Janneke Schoopman stepped down as the head coach of Indian women's hockey. Dronacharya Award winner Harendra Singh has coached various Indian teams including the senior men's hockey team.

- The first decline in unicorn formation in India was estimated due to low investment despite the stock market peaking in 2024. Indian founders are excellent at building offshore unicorns. The global unicorn landscape in 2024 sees significant developments and challenges, as highlighted in the Hurun Global Unicorn Stalkers. India is at third position with 67 unicorns.
- In an important step towards strengthening India's mineral security, Mineral Videsh India Limited and Council of Scientific and Industrial Research Institute of Minerals and Materials have signed an MoU for Technology and Technology. Knowledge Collaboration, EXIT aims to leverage the technical strength of CSIR IMMT for various critical areas.
- India has invoked the peace clause at the World
