Indian Institute of Management Kashipur (popularly known as IIM Kashipur) is the thirteenth IIM to be established in India. Founded in the year 2011, IIM Kashipur provides high quality management education to young minds and working professionals.

- Executive Post Graduate Programme in Management (EPGPM)
- Doctoral Executive Fellowship Programme in Management

Getting into IIM Kashipur(IIM-Ka)

IIM-Ka Results Accepted

For PGPM

- Domestic Candidates (in India) CAT
- International Candidate (outside India) GMAT For EPGPM - Candidates having a valid test score of CAT or GMAT.

IIM Kashipur Eligibility

Eligibility For PGP

- The candidates must hold a Bachelor's Degree, with at least 50% marks or equivalent CGPA [45% in case of the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled Tribe (ST) and Differently Abled (DA)] awarded by any of the Universities incorporated by an act of the central or state legislature in India or other educational institutions established by an act of Parliament or declared to be deemed as a University under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, or must possess an equivalent qualification recognized by the Ministry of HRD, Government of India.
- Candidates appearing for the final year bachelor's degree / equivalent qualification examination and those who have completed the degree requirement and are awaiting results can also apply. The candidates are required to have obtained at least 50% marks or equivalent till the latest examination.

Eligibility for FPM

 Master's degree in any discipline, with at least 55 per cent marks and at least 50% marks at Bachelors' degree level.

Or,

Five year/ four year Integrated Masters' Degree programme in any discipline, with at least 55 percent marks Or,

Professional qualifications like CA, ICWA, CS with at least 55 percent marks and at least 50% marks at Bachelors' degree level.

Or,

4 year/8 semester Bachelor's degree with at least 60 percent marks or equivalent grade point average

Eligibility For EPGPM

- The candidate must hold a Bachelor's Degree, with at least 50% marks or equivalent CGPA [45% in case of the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled Tribe (ST) and Differently Abled (DA) (It may also referred to as Persons with Disability (PWD) category)], awarded by any of the Universities incorporated by an act of the central or state legislature in India or other educational institutions established by an act of Parliament or declared to be deemed as a University under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, or possess an equivalent qualification recognized by the Ministry of HRD, Government of India.
- Work Experience: The candidate must have a minimum of three years of full-time work experience as on August 1, 2016.




IIM Kashipur Admission Procedure

• PGP

Candidates will be shortlisted on the basis of their CAT scores and their previous academic performance. Shortlisted candidates are called for a round of Personal Interview (PI) and Writing Ability Test (WAT). Merit list will be generated on the basis of the performance in test, PI and the CAT score.

• EPGPM

The students first have to fill the application form. Eligible candidates are required to appear for written test. Shortlisted candidates face a round of personal interview after which admission letter is offered to them.



Selection Criteria for PGP at IIM-Kashipur

The admission process of IIM Kashipur takes into consideration the candidate's performance in CAT, performance in Personal Interview (PI) and Written Analysis Test (WAT), academic record and relevant work experience.

Performance in CAT

IIM Kashipur uses the CAT scores for choosing students for PI-WAT round. The table given below shows minimum percentile expected from candidates to be shortlisted for the PI & WAT. These percentages are necessary to achieve but not sufficient to get admission. Students should aim for higher percentile.




The total weightage for parameters (CAT, WAT and PI) in the final selection stage has been kept at 82%. This ensures that the applicants, who do not have a good academic profile or work experience can still aspire to join IIM Kashipur by preparing well for CAT, WAT and PI rounds.

The revised fee for PGPM and EPGPM is approximately Rupees. 6 lakhs.




