History of 7th April

- ◆ **1948** : The World Health Organization, the health affairs agency of the United Nations, was established, which is celebrated as World Health Day.
- ◆ **1920** : Famous sitar player Pandit Ravi Shankar was born.
- ◆ **2000** : Delhi Police in India had exposed cricket match fixing and betting stock worth crores of rupees.
- ◆ **1998** : World Health Organization declared World Health Day as Women's Health Day.

Current Affairs Related to 7th April

- ◆ The Reserve Bank of India is considering setting up a Digital India Trust Agency to stem the spread of illegal lending apps. Its first objective is to strengthen cyber security measures and prevent bankruptcies in the digital lending sector.
- ◆ The Indian Coast Guard ships supported and CIGS Innovation are participating in Exercise Dosti-16 with the Indian Coast Guard ship Samudura, while the Bangladesh ships are lighting the important aspects of cooperation and interoperability between Indian and Sri Lankan coast guard sailors. Restaur Defense Minister Mohammad Ghassan Maumoon said the triumvirate exercise aims to unite the troika to address shared maritime security challenges through friendship cooperation.
- ◆ AU Scoll Finance Bank has merged with Fin Business Small Finance Bank, strengthening its presence in South India. Stock supplement approved as per Shepherd's approval. The integration has created a customer base of 1 crore.
- ◆ The National Highways Authority of India has designated one vehicle, one FASTag, with the aim of facilitating the use of a single FASTag for multiple communities or linking multiple FASTags. Keeping an eye on the prospects posed by the launch of Paytm Fastag, NHAI had earlier extended the connectivity limit till March end.
- ◆ Sorin Investment Fund superstar Sanjay Nair has taken over as the president of industry body ASSOCHAM for 2024-2025. ASSOCHAM gave this information. Nair replaces Ajay Singh, director of portfolio and management at SynopseJet.
- ◆ Paradip Port Authority, Odisha has promoted Colorado Port Authority, Kandola as India's top cargo-handling major port in 2023-2024. Paradip Port to dispatch 145.38 million tonnes of tunnel cargo in 2023-2024.
- ◆ Tata Technologies and BMW Group have partnered to set up automotive software and IT development centers in Chennai, Pune and Bengaluru. With Chennai leading the way in manufacturing IT solutions for auto giants like Winston, Ford and Renault Nissan, the focus here will be on business IT solutions.
- ◆ Securities and Exchange Board of India has launched SCORE 2.0, an upgraded version of its securities system to strengthen the system. This advanced system includes automated routing, inspection by designated officials and streamlined routines. SEBI Grievance Redressal System marked SEBI Score was launched in June 2011 as an online portal.
- ◆ PepsiCo India's huge investment in Madhya Pradesh promises economic development and job opportunities for the new flavor manufacturing facility. In an important step, PepsiCo India has announced a big investment of Rs 1266 crore in the medium market of Madhya Pradesh. Set for operational opening in the first quarter of 2026, the plant marks a significant moment for both PepsiCo and the local industry.
- ◆ Scientists in South Korea announced a new world record by heating an artificial sun to a temperature of 100 million degrees Celsius for a record duration of 48 seconds. The temperature of the Korea Institute of Fusion Energy's Korea Superconducting Tokamak Advanced Research Fusion Reactor is seven times hotter than the Sun's core. The purpose of this nuclear fusion is to replicate the reaction that makes it possible for the Sun and other stars to shine.
- ◆ The Supreme Court of India established the Fact Check Unit, for which temporary stays are put on the notifications of the Central Government. This comes after an appeal was filed in the Bombay High Court challenging the Digital Information Technology Rules, 2023, which empowers the government to identify frozen news on social media platforms.
