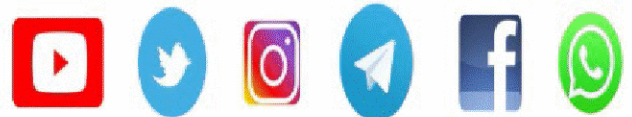

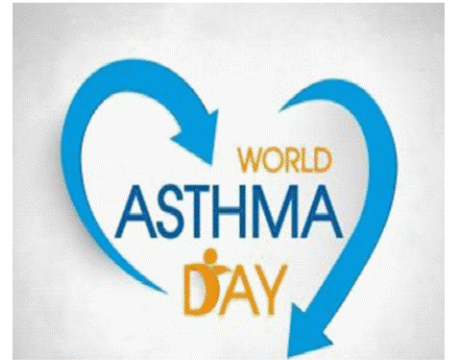
- ◆ **India's Bharat 6G Alliance** is set to sign an agreement with **Europe's Industry Alliance** 6G following a similar exit with the US. The combined objective is to promote cooperation in developing 6G technology. India 6G Alliance and Institute Alliance 6G are set to sign a contract soon, with plans to finalize support details in the coming quarter.
- ◆ **India has selected its 15-member squad for the ICC Men's T20 World Cup 2024**, which is led by experienced Rohit Sharma. It also announced the team's exclusive involvement in various stores, detailing the role a number of stocks will play. Finally, the selection ritual has paired Rishabh Pant and Sanju Samson who are looking to return to international cricket in December 2022 after a gap of a year due to a serious accident.
- ◆ **Investigation India has projected India's e-commerce market to reach \$325 by 2030**, with the country's digital economy expected to reach \$800. Currently worth US\$70, online shopping accounts for 7% of the total retail market in India, indicating the potential for expansion. Factors such as high internet penetration, scientific internet services and increasing rural level are set to further grow this sector.
- ◆ **Modi International Dr. Bina Modi, Chairman and Managing Director of KK Modi Group**, was honored by the Vice President of India Jagdeep Dhankhar for her outstanding contribution in the field of corporate responsibility. During this, the new building of Samman Society of Indian Law Firms was inaugurated, in which the distinguished chief guest was present.
- ◆ **Mumps is a viral disease caused by the MMPS virus**, which belongs to the paramyxovirus family. This virus develops the salivary nerve.
- ◆ **The Indian milk products manufacturer will originally** be a part of the US and South Africa squad during the **T20 World Cup in June**. The cricket boards of both the teams stopped it. Exclusive entry for co-hosts into the US tournament, taking place from June 1. The tournament and finals will feature several Westlands. The first match of the World Cup will be between America and Canada on June 1.
- ◆ **The Government of India has signed an agreement to train and capacity build 1500 Bangladeshi officials from 2025 to 2030**. The Executive was signed by the Department of Reforms and Public Grievances of the Government of India and the Ministry of Public Administration of Bangladesh of the Government of Bangladesh.
- ◆ **Worldline Payments India has announced acquisition of Reserve Bank of India** as a payment aggregator. It reflects the company's heritage towards the Indian certified market and is well integrated into the offline payments landscape, with emphasis on its sales. The move aims to safeguard updated supervision and strengthen certified supervision.
- ◆ **Indian Oil Corporation has announced a significant investment of Rs 5215 crore** to develop 1 GW energy capacity in India. This prestigious move is benchmark of Aysomi's broader diversification strategy beyond the traditional oil and gas venture.
- ◆ **A round trip to the Moon has begun for the Chang'e-6 lunar probe**, marking a significant advance in their space orbit. The mission's mission to the Moon is to collect samples of soil and rocks from the far side, providing an important insight into its early evolution and the inner Solar System.
