History of November 29

- ♦ 1947: When the Indian subcontinent was partitioned the Nizam wanted to remain independent rather than joining India.

- Courier company Blue Dart has launched digital parcel locker service in post offices in partnership with India Post. According to the statement issued by Blue Dart, with this service people will be able to collect their belongings from digital parcel lockers in post offices. This eliminates the need for individual receipts or signatures for packages. Blue Dart and India Post have entered into a strategic partnership for enhanced services.
- ♦ Securities and Exchange Board of India Chairperson Madhabi Puri Buch has officially launched the Investor Risk Reduction Access Platform at the Bombay Stock Exchange. Developed under the guidance of Market Infrastructure Institutions under the supervision of SEBI, the Investor Risk Reduction Access Platform is designed to reduce the risks faced by investors during technical disruptions at the trading member's end, including both primary and disaster recovery sites. Is included.
- The world's largest single-site solar power plant was inaugurated by the United Arab Emirates. The two gigawatt capacity Al Dhafra solar photovoltaic power project is 35 kilometers from Abu Dhabi and will generate electricity for approximately two million homes. This plant is expected to emit 2.4 million tonnes of carbon emissions annually. The project is in line with the UAE's Net Zero 2050 target, strengthening its leadership in solar energy production on a per capita basis.
- ♦ BBC has released the list of the most inspiring and influential women around the world for 2023. These include human rights lawyer Amal Clooney, Hollywood actress America Ferrera, feminist icon Gloria Steinem, former US First Lady Michelle Obama, beauty business startups Huda Katan and Ballon Di and title-winning footballer Aitana Bhanmati.
- In 2018 Dr. Langlands received the prestigious Abel Prize for his visionary Langlands Program linking representation theory with number theory.

- The World Coal Association will be renamed as FutureCoal: Global Alliance for Sustainable Coal. WCA, the global platform for the coal sector, will shut down after almost four decades. Following the call for modernization from coal and allied sectors, WCA has transformed itself into a new identity, FutureCoal.
- Taking an important step towards combating drug abuse, an MoU was signed between the two under the Drug Free India Campaign in New Delhi. The initiative aims to synergize efforts to prevent drug use, especially among the youth, in line with Prime Minister Modi's vision of a substance-free India. Presently it is being implemented in 372 identified highly sensitive districts. The campaign aims to create awareness about the ill effects of substance abuse among the youth with a special focus on higher education institutions, university campuses and schools.
- Kerala's pioneering responsible tourism mission has won global praise by securing a place in the prestigious list of case studies curated by the United Nations World Tourism Organisation. This recognition not only reflects the Mission's commitment towards eco-friendly tourism, but also serves as an inspiration for further progress in promoting sustainable travel.
- Telangana has unveiled the world's first 3D printed temple located at Burugupalli in Siddipet district. Which is a phenomenal structure located at Burugupalli in Siddipet district. This innovative creation, achieved through a three-month 3D printing process, is a significant technological achievement.
- Indian Mission to ASEAN along with the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare hosted the ASEAN India Millet Festival in Jakarta. The festival is celebrated as part of the International Year of Millets 2023. The food festival began with the showcase of culinary skills through innovative millet dishes and the participation of millet-based food producing organizations and startups.




