History of 29th April

- ♦ 1639: The foundation of the Red Fort in Delhi was reduced to ashes.
- ♦ 1547: Bhamashah, a friend, colleague and trusted advisor of Mewar investor Pratap, was born.
- ♦ 1997 : The ban on chemical usage came into effect.
- 1236: Iltutmish, a prominent ruler of the Slave dynasty in the Delhi Sultanate, died.
- ◆ 1993 : Buckingham Palace was opened to the general public for the first time.

Current Affairs Related to 29th April 2024

- The European Parliament has adopted air pollution limits which are strict and legally binding. These strict legally binding air pollution limits must be complied with by 2030. Air pollution causes three lakh premature deaths in Europe every year. This number can be reduced by 70% in the next ten years through strict EU rules. Air quality in Europe has improved over the past decade.
- ◆ The Retail Summit 2024 was held in Dubai, whose agenda was based on eight key themes. It is a major global event focusing on the future of retail. These topics aim to address the key challenges and opportunities faced by metal sellers around the world.
- ♦ Reliance Jio has become the world's largest mobile operator by defeating China Mobile in terms of data traffic. The total traffic on Jio network has reached 40.9 exabytes with an increase of 35.2% year on year. Jio has a very strong and wide customer base of 48.18 million. It is transforming India with 108 million True 5G customers.
- ReservePay and Airtel Paytm Bank to promote digital payments, offer UPI switch to cloud-based storage infrastructure. In an unprecedented collaboration, Razorpay and Airtel Paytm Bank have unveiled UPI Switch, a unique cloud-based infrastructure designed to revolutionize the digital payments land-scape. This innovative product increases the success rate to 4.5% and promises an unrealistic 10000% detection rate per second, giving NMON exceptional scannability.
- ♦ PEU, a digital payment service provider, has obtained the Payment Aggregator Act 2007 from the Reserve Bank of India to act as a payment aggregator. This approval, after a year long process, marks a significant moment for PEU's operations in India.

- Indian passport is the second cheapest passport in the world after UAE. Indian passports are also the cheapest in terms of cost per year of validity. However, Indians can travel visa-free to only 62 countries with an Indian passport. An Australian firm Compare the Market AU has conducted this study.
- The Reserve Bank of India has ordered Kotak Mahindra Bank to stop adding new customers and issuing new credit cards through its online and mobile banking channels. However, RBI said in the order that the bank can provide services to its existing customers including its credit card customers. Action has become necessary based on the significant concerns arising from the IT audit of the Reserve Bank for the years 2022 and 2023 and the Bank's continued failure to address these concerns in a comprehensive and timely manner.
- ♦ The UN FISH report highlights an increase of 1.44 million children in India's census, of which 24 are under the age of 14, who are expected to grow to the age of 77 years. Despite progress in maternal health, underdevelopment persists among people living on the reserve margins.
- ♦ UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres has appointed India's Geeta Sabha as the new UN Resident Coordinator in Indonesia. Sabharwal builds on his nearly three decades of experience in supporting the Goals, development, climate, change, sustainable peace, governance and social policy by leveraging digital technology and data to accelerate sustainable development planning.
- Murmu has appointed Professor Naima Khatoon as the first woman patriarch of the Critical Muslim University. It comes under scrutiny as part of the pro-BJP government's outreach to Muslim women, which comes just days after the second phase of Muslim elections.
