History of 13 April

- ♦ 1648 : The construction of Red Fort was completed.
- ◆ 1699 : Guru Gobind Singh established the Kalsa sect of the Sikhs.
- ♦ 1978: The country's first flag carrier ship I Shioj Delhi was decommissioned.
- ♦ 1796: The first elephant in America was brought to India
- ♦ 1939 : The Hindustani Red Army was formed in India for armed struggle with the British.
- ♦ 1952: The first Parliament session of independent India began.

Current Affairs Related to 13 April

- GUJCOST has been appointed as the Research Center for ISRO's START programme, which aims to enhance capability and training in the field of space science and technology. Conceived by ISRO, this program provides an introductory online platform covering various areas of space science research.
- ♦ Small Industries Development Bank of India has partnered with fintech platform KarmaLife to finance micro loans. The collaboration aims to achieve financial inclusion by leveraging KarmaLife's mobile app technology to access loans without the need for extensive paperwork. KarmaLife's mobile app helps remove the traditional hassles associated with micro loans, making gig finance easier to access.
- The Supreme Court's decision expanded the scope of Articles 14 and 21 to include the right against the adverse effects of climate change. Article 48 (i) of the Constitution provides that the State shall endeavor to protect and improve the environment and to protect the forests and wildlife of the country. Article 51. The clause states that it shall be the duty of every citizen of India to protect and improve the natural environment including forests, lakes, rivers and wildlife and to have compassion for living beings.
- A new gold-backed currency called the Rupee has been introduced by Zimbabwe. The meaning of the name Rpal is Zimbabwe Gold. New Rupee Banknote Rs 1 And Rs 200. Will fall in the denomination between Rs. Coins will also be introduced to address the shortage of American coins. It is the latest effort to stabilize an economy that has lurched from crisis to crisis for the past 25 years.
- ◆ Tata Advanced Systems Limited announced the successful deployment of sub meter resolution optical satellite TSAT-1A.
- Air India has appointed Jai Shanmugam, an industry veteran with 25 years of experience, as Head of Global Airport Operations.

- Food Safety and Standards Authority of India has launched awareness campaigns on food safety aspects in major markets of New Delhi. This campaign has been started in collaboration with Food Safety Department, Delhi. It will primarily focus on detection and reduction of pesticide residues and food product contaminants. During the programme, owners of food businesses were sensitized on issues like the value of organic farming and the need for testing of raw materials.
- The seventh round of trade treaty talks between India and Peru began in New Delhi. The objective of the meeting is to strengthen bilateral cooperation to increase trade and investment between the two countries. These initiatives are a testament to India's commitment to strengthen bilateral relations and accelerate economic development with Peru.
- Sitars and tanpuras made in Miraj, a small town in Maharashtra, have got the Geological Survey tag. This area is famous for making musical instruments. It comes in Sangli district. The opposition has claimed that these instruments were made in Mirage. There is a huge demand among the artists of classical music as well as the artists associated with the film industry.
- Famous author Sam Pitroda has written a new book titled The Memorial of Democracy, which details the current state of democracy and its inauguration in countries like India and the United States. Democrat Sibal and other eminent personalities from the literary world participated in the book revival program.
- Tigiant Wipro has announced the death of its CEO Thierry Delaporte. In his place, the company's board of directors has appointed Srinivas Palliya as the new Chief Executive Officer and Administrative Director.
