History of December 12

- ◆ 1232 : Iltutmish, ruler of the Ghulam dynasty, captured Gwalior.
- 1996: A30-year treaty was signed between India and Bangladesh regarding the sharing of Ganga water.
- ♦ 1911 : The capital of India was shifted from Calcutta to Delhi.
- ◆ 1971: The facilities provided to former kings were canceled by the Indian Parliament.

Current Affairs Related to 12 December

- Sweden and the United States sign defense cooperation agreement in Washington. This agreement will allow the US access to all military bases in Sweden. Sweden is about to join the North Atlantic Treaty Organization, a transatlantic security alliance. This agreement would create better conditions for Sweden to receive support from the US in the event of war or crisis. It is currently negotiating such agreements with two other Nordic countries, Finland and Denmark.
- The government took the initiative to set up subsidized food stores at Delhi Metro stations. To address the rising prices of essential food items, the central government is set to launch retail stores at major metro stations in Delhi. The aim of this initiative is to provide kitchen essentials including onions, pulses and flour to metro passengers at discounted prices. The first proposed store will be located at Rajiv Chowk Metro Station in Central Delhi, marking the beginning of this ambitious project.
- Ujjivan Small Finance Bank recently partnered with Watervantah, a global non-profit, to increase access to safe water.org and sanitation through affordable financing. Which is a renowned global non-profit organization dedicated to providing access to safe water and sanitation through affordable financing solutions.
- Indian-origin writer Meera Chand has shared this prestigious honor with novelist Suchen Christine Lim and Malay dance legend Osman Abdul Hamid. Singapore awarded its prestigious Cultural Medallion to three distinguished individuals in recognition of their artistic excellence and significant contribution to the country's rich arts and culture.
- ♦ According to S&P Global, LIC achieved fourth global position in 2022. The top three insurers are Allianz SE, China Life Insurance and Nippon Life Insurance. LIC's reserves reached \$503.7 billion.

- A wonderful moment was witnessed at the Red Sea International Film Festival. Bollywood actor Ranveer Singh was honored by Sharon Stone. This festival was organized in Jeddah, Saudi Arabia. Hollywood actress Diane Kruger and Saudi actor-writer Abdullah Al Sadhan were also in the running for this award.
- ♦ Amazon India received the National Award for Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities. This recognition serves as a testament to Amazon India's unwavering commitment to fostering a diverse and equitable workplace where everyone has the opportunity to thrive.
 - The world's largest and most advanced experimental nuclear fusion reactor JT-60SA has officially started operations in Ibaraki Prefecture, Japan. JT-60SA developed as a collaborative effort between the European Union and Japan. represents an important step in harnessing the potential of nuclear fusion as a clean and sustainable energy source.
