## History of 13th July

- ♦ 1945: The Indian Independence Act was passed by the British Parliament.
- ♦ 1977: During the Emergency, public honors like Bharat Ratna, Padya Vibhushan etc. were withdrawn.
- ♦ 1905 : Calcutta's weekly newspaper Sanjivani first suggested boycotting British goods.
- 1803 : Raja Ram Mohan Roy and Alexander Duff started the Scottish Church College with five students.

## Current Affairs Related to 13th July 2024

- Under the Tree Plantation Mass Campaign 2024, the Uttar Pradesh government has announced to establish Mitra Van. Mitra Forest will be established on the borders of UP and neighboring country Nepal. Uttar Pradesh Forest Department, along with neighboring states and the country, is working to plant 35 crore saplings in an effort to increase greenery. The Forest Department will also involve dignitaries from other states in this mega campaign. After the target date of 20th July, the Forest Department is committed to make the Tree Plantation Mass Campaign 2024 a success.
- ♦ Women Entrepreneurship Forum and TransUnion CIBIL have launched Human Resource Empowerment Society programme. It will empower women entrepreneurs in India with financial literacy content and business skills. The Women Entrepreneurship Forum aims to create an enabling ecosystem for women entrepreneurs in India. It is a public private partnership platform incubated at NITI Aayog.
- ♦ ISRO Chairman launches Indian Space Hackathon. Twelve problem statements have been identified for the hackathon in geospatial domain, space science, image processing and AI/ML areas. A team of three to four students can participate in the hackathon and solve challenges with innovative solutions. Initially 100 teams will be selected based on their ideas, and later 30 teams will be shortlisted by an expert committee for the finals.
- ↑ The Food Safety and Standards Authority of India has approved a proposal to display nutritional information such as total sugar, salt and saturated fat in large and bold letters on the labels of packaged food items. In the 44th meeting of FSSAI, it was decided to amend the Food Safety and Standards Regulations 2020 regarding nutrition information labeling. The draft notification for the amendment will now be placed in the public domain for further suggestions and objections.

- The United Nations Food and Agriculture Organization has revised its estimate of world grain production in 2024 to a record-breaking 2854 million tonnes. The report said corn forecasts were kept high due to expectations of better corn crops in Argentina and Brazil, as well as Turkey and Ukraine, which offset the downgrade in forecasts for Indonesia, Pakistan and several southern African countries. will do it.
- LIC has launched Jeevan Samarth Project to meet the changing needs of its customers. LIC has teamed up with AT Karnay to execute this transformative project. To execute this project, LIC will review its existing agency structure from beginning to end. LIC hopes to transform its agency ecosystem through this project to better meet the ever-changing demands of millions of Indian families.
- Aiming to further the indigenization and modernization efforts of the Indian Armed Forces, state-owned DRDO unveiled the Zoravar light tank at its plant in Hazira, Gujarat. This 25 tonne light tank has been designed and developed in a record two years through a public-private partnership between DRDO and Larsen & Toubro. The prototype light tank is powered by a 750 hp Cummins engine, which will be replaced by a domestically developed engine in future units.
- The Secretary level meeting between the Defense Ministries of India and the Democratic Republic of Congo was held in New Delhi. The Indian delegation was led by Defense Secretary Shri Giridhar Aramane, while the Congolese delegation was led by DRC Major General Lukuikila Matikwija Marcel. Representatives of both the countries discussed ways to promote cooperation in training and defense industry.
