History of 27the February

- ♦ 1931: Chandrashekhar Azad, a revolutionary and founder of the freedom struggle, shot himself along with the British police in Allahabad's Alfred Park.
- ♦ 1557: Russian Embassy opened in London.
- ♦ 1988 : Helicopter postal service was inaugurated for the first time.
- ♦ 2001 : 59 Hindu Kar Sevaks were killed in the bungalow of Kar Sevaks returning from Ayodhya in Godhra, Gujarat.
- ◆ 1956 : Women got the right to vote in Egypt.

Current Affairs Related 27th February

- RBI has given approval to HDFC Bank to sell 90% stake in HDFC Credila. HDFC Bank's HDFC Credila will continue. HDFC Bank will sell 90% stake in HDFC Credila to a consortium of private equity investors including BPEA EQT and ChrisCapital Group.
- India's first Helicopter Emergency Medical Service (HEMS) will start from Uttarakhand. Civil Aviation Minister Bluetooth Company gave this information. Under this service, a helicopter has been installed at the All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) from where it can be sent even to normal places at a distance of 150 degrees so that medical care can be provided to any person in case of an accident. Logistics (Department DOT) is the launch of the 'Sangam: Digital Twin' initiative, which is being reshaped through an apprenticeship and collaboration institute with industry leaders, AMSMEA education investors and innovators. There has been a demand to join hands.
- Encounter events including Volk's injury, Nagal's part and Fulfilling his Dream were released in 2021.
- Last year, the Chennai Challenger marked a comeback from surgery following its success.
- Ruchira Kamboj, India's distinguished representative to the United Nations, recently took oath as the Chairperson of the 62nd session of the Social Development Commission.
- ♦ The court supremo rejected the listed band plan from shareholders, criticizing the inclusion of political parties among its supporters. The decision was led by Chief Justice Diwai Chandrachud.
- ◆ The Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways signed an MoU with IIM Shillong to set up India's first Gati Shakti Research Chair. This Chair will contribute to high quality academic research on multimodal logistics with a focus on the North East.

- The Union Cabinet has approved the proposal of Department of Water Resources, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation to continue FMBAP with a total outlay of Rs 4100 crore. The work under the RMBA component will be completed with 100% central assistance.
- In a development announced by India's Transport Ministry, the country is set to begin testing GPS-based toll collection (Global Navigation System) on the Mysore-Bengaluru Expressway. The move is a push by the government to modernize supermarkets and improve transportation.
- The Indian government is preparing to modernize toll collection on the Masu-Bengaluru Expressway with GNSS-based tolling, aimed at improving traffic flow and making toll payment easier for commuters.
- Qianling Station, located in one of the most mysterious places on the planet, is set to become a center of scientific research. The establishment of this station marks China's biggest role in polar science, an area that has important implications for understanding climate change, sea level rise and other global impacts.
- Saudi Arabia is preparing to launch its global journey named Dream of the Desert. This will be the first international train in the Middle East, which will offer passengers travel to Saudi Arabia. With its promise of luxury and cultural immersion, this new venture is poised to become a classic for you. Inauguration by the end of 2024, ahead of launch in NEET 2025 for the first train.
- China has officially opened the Qianling Station in Antarctica. This important development marks a new chapter in China's scientific exploration and research in the Antarctic region.
- Nagal's journey in 2023 began when he played as the world number 506 and sought advice for the ATP Chennai Open Challenger.


