Current Affairs Related to 27th June 2024

- To realize the vision of tackling tree plantation on National Highways, NHAI will take a unique initiative of planting Miyawaki trees on land parcels around National Highways. Over 53 acres of land area has been identified to establish Miyawaki plantations at various locations in and around Delhi-NCR. The objective of this event is to create dense, native and biodiverse forests in a short period of time.
- ♦ The government has said that the MoU has been signed between the National Highway Authority of India and Delhi's Indraprastha Institute of Information Technologies with the aim of strengthening road safety through Artificial Intelligence. This initiative of the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways will use artificial intelligence to improve the availability of road signs.
- Chief of Defense Staff General Anil Chauhan released the Joint Doctrine for Cyberspace Operations during the Chiefs of Staff Committee meeting in New Delhi. Joint Doctrine is a keystone publication that will guide commanders in conducting cyberspace operations in today's complex military operating environments. The development of joint doctrines is an important aspect of integration and integration, a step that is being actively pursued by the Indian Armed Forces.
- The United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees named Theo James as its new Goodwill Ambassador. On this important day in the global humanitarian conflict, the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees proudly announces the appointment of British actor Theo James as its new Goodwill Ambassador.
- The Patna High Court struck down the Bihar government's laws increasing the reservation for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Backward Classes and Extremely Backward Classes from 50% to 65%. On November 9, the Bihar Assembly had approved the Bihar Reservation Act, 2023 and the Bihar Reservation of Vacancies in Posts and Services Act, 2023.

- An agreement was signed between the National Highway Authority of India and Indraprastha Institute of Information Technology, Delhi, which aims to enhance road safety through the deployment of Artificial Intelligence. This initiative will leverage Artificial Intelligence based solutions to improve the availability of road signs on National Highways. Highways of approximately 25,000 km length will be covered under this project.
- ♦ A policy-based loan of US\$170 million was approved by the multilateral development lender Asian Development Bank to improve India's health system preparedness and ability to respond to future pandemics. The funding will help implement the government's National Health Policy 2017 on strong and scalable action for resilient and transformative health systems.
- ♦ The Union Cabinet chaired by PM Narendra Modi approved Viability Gap Financing Scheme for Offshore Wind Energy Projects at a total outlay of Rs 7453 crore. This includes an outlay of Rs 6853 crore for setting up and commissioning of 1 GW offshore wind power projects.
- ♦ Bhartrihari Mahtab has been appointed Protem Speaker of the 18th Lok Sabha. He has been appointed by President Draupadi Murmu. He has been MP from Cuttack seven times. Opposition leaders said the government has ignored the tradition of giving this honor to Kodikunnil Suresh, the senior-most Congress MP. He has been MP eight times.
- India, France, Australia trilateral meeting identifies new proposals for expanding Indo-Pacific partnership. They identified new proposals to advance trilateral cooperation. This includes the Indo Pacific Ocean Initiative and Indian Ocean Rim Association mechanisms, within the framework of humanitarian assistance and disaster relief cooperation and multilateral engagement.
