History of February 19

- ♦ 1398 : Sultan Ghiyasuddin Tughlaq II of Delhi was assassinated.

Current Affairs Related to 19 February

- Dhami campaign against drugs was launched by Uttarakhand Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami. Earlier, Dhami called upon the people of the state to come forward to help the government in its resolve to make the state drug free by the year 2025. Apart from this, he organized a high level meeting and directed the officials to rapidly involve students and colleges in the campaign to achieve the goal of drugfree Uttarakhand by the year 2025.
- ♦ The Annual Performance Report of the Indian Banking Sector, in accordance with Section 36(2) of the Banking Regulation Act, 1949, presents a comprehensive analysis of the achievements and challenges of the sector. It includes co-operative banks and non-banking financial companies, providing information about their contribution to the economic structure of the country. The report highlights the strength of India's banking system and NBFCs.
- Russian astronaut Oleg Kononenko has created new history. He has made a world record for staying in space for the most number of days. 59-year-old Kononenko achieved this feat by breaking the record of his own country's astronaut Gennady Padalka.
- In a strategic move within the Indian Army, Lieutenant General Upendra Dwivedi has been appointed as the new Vice Chief of the Army Staff with effect. The changes mark a seamless succession plan as Lt Gen Dwivedi steps into the role, succeeding Lt Gen MV Suchindra Kumar.
- ♠ REC Limited, a Maharatna Central Public Sector Enterprise and leading NBFC under the Ministry of Power, has been awarded the prestigious Best Green Bond Corporate Award at the Asset Triple A Awards for Sustainable Finance. This recognition underlines REC's commitment to sustainable finance and environmental sustainability. In April 2023, REC issued USD Green Bonds worth \$750 million, a milestone first for India since assuming the G20 Chairmanship.

- Elon Musk announced the successful implantation of the Neuralink device in a human. This device is essentially the size of a large coin, manufactured specifically to be implanted in the skull for brain computer interface. Neuralink has received approval from the US Food and Drug Administration under the Investigational Device Exemption. It is a technology that enables direct communication between the brain and external devices such as computers or prosthetics, without using traditional neuromuscular pathways such as nerves and muscles.
- The Civil Aviation Ministry has given in-principle approval for the installation of a 242-feet tall statue of Adiyogi Shiva near the upcoming Noida International Airport at Jewar in western Uttar Pradesh. This important decision paves the way for the establishment of this spiritual milestone for Isha Foundation. Under the leadership of Sadhguru Jaggi Vasudev, Isha Foundation is renowned for its commitment towards yoga, environmental stewardship and social welfare.
- Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi addressed the prestigious World Government Summit in Dubai. This was their second invitation to the WGS, the first being in 2018. The WGS was an annual global gathering held in Dubai. 2013 convenes world leaders, policy makers and experts to tackle global issues.
- Mahotsav begins its journey in the culturally rich Kutch district of Gujarat, marking the beginning of a vibrant celebration of the performing arts. India's foremost theater festival, the prestigious Bharat Rang Mahotsav has been inaugurated in Gujarat's Kutch district, marking the beginning of a vibrant tribute to the performing arts.
- Pawan Kumar assumed charge after approval from the Appointments Committee of the Cabinet. Kumar is an officer of the Indian Cost Accounts Service under the Department of Expenditure of the Finance Ministry. Earlier he was holding the charge of Additional Chief Advisor.


- 1. In which year will the FIFA World Cup final be held at the MetLife Stadium in New York City?
