History of 6th April

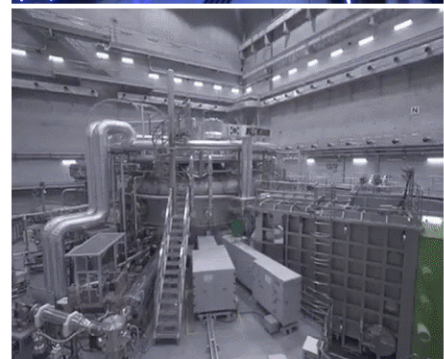
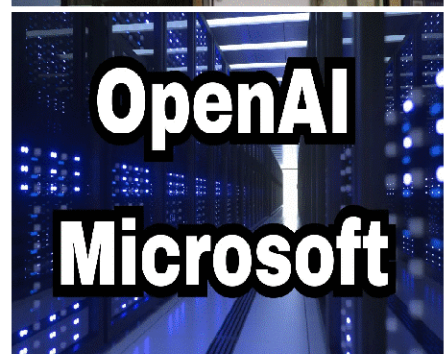
- ◆ **1606** : Prince **Khusro** fought against the rebellion of his father, **Mughal ruler Jahangir**.
- ◆ **1919** : The **Rowlatt Act** was introduced against the **Civil Disobedience Movement** under Mahatma Gandhi, which led to the first all-India attack.
- ◆ **1980** : India's political party **Bharatiya Janata Party** was established.
- ◆ **1957** : The **Soviet Union** conducted a **nuclear test**.

Current Affairs Related to 6th April

- ◆ **The World Bank** has said that the **Indian economy** will grow by **7.5 percent** in the financial year 2024. The World Bank has revised its earlier estimate by 1.2 percent. The new estimate is that the country's economy has grown by a spectacular 8.4 percent during the October-December quarter. The Finance Minister said that the economy is on track to grow at 8 percent growth rate in the January-March quarter. The growth rate in fiscal year 2025 will be 6.6 percent.
- ◆ **The northern Indian state of Uttar Pradesh** has led the way in having the **highest number** of Geographical Indication certified products in the country. With the addition of 15 new laptops, Uttar Pradesh now has a total of 69 G-tagged products, up from 58 last year. The holy city of Varanasi features prominently in the production of GI tagged goods with 30 sculptural sculptures, the highest in any one geographical region.
- ◆ **Government of India chocolate sales** in the **government company for 2023/2024** reached \$1.98, 9% below the target, which are grandly influenced by priority and target establishment. The Government of India aims to eliminate money laundering through sales in state-run associates in FY 2023?2024. However, the realization amount of Rs 165 billion reached the target of \$1.98 billion, almost 9% less than the internal target.
- ◆ **Jayshree Das Verma** has occupied the post of **41st National President of the industry** body FICCI Women's Organization. FLO is the oldest club organization in South East Asia. Verma has been appointed by Israel as its Honorary Consul to India. He is also the director of human rights firm Kapro Mirza Solutions Pvt. Ltd.
- ◆ **Stephen Jain, Managing Director, Times Group**, received the prestigious **Exchange4Media News Broadcasting Awards Lifetime Achievement Award 2023** for his significant contribution to Indian television news.
- ◆ **Microsoft and Open Florida** are collaborating on a **massive data center project** that could cost as much as \$100 billion, according to Budd. The goal of this project is to develop an artificial supercomputer called Stargate. Microsoft and Open Hotel Company are planning to build a series of supercomputers in the next six years. Their goal is to build the largest supercomputer, funded by Microsoft, which would cost approximately 100 times the largest final data supply.
- ◆ **Jawaharlal Nehru University Teachers Association** appointed **new constitution for 2024-2025**. Basu, a professor at the School of International Studies at the University of Massachusetts, has been appointed president of the DSM, a statement said. Meenakshi Sundriyal and Pradeep K Shinde have been appointed vice presidents in the teachers' organization. Shahid Akhir Hussain has been appointed secretary while Vikas Bajpai and Kaushal Kishore Chandel have been appointed vice presidents.
- ◆ **There is a lot of talk about artificial studios**. The first Hindi film on this subject, **Irah Ka Telecom**, and its song was launched in Mumbai. Rohit Bose Roy, Rajesh Sharma, Amarat Kotak and Surakshit Bhandari are in the lead roles in the film. Produced by Big Films Media and directed by Sam Bhattacharjee, the film is set to release in Superstar across the country through Impel Digital Theatrical Distribution.
- ◆ **Girija Subramaniam, the current Chairman and MD of the agriculture company**, has been selected as the next CMD of New India Insurance. The next chairmen and managing directors are selected for the offices of the Bureau of Financial Services, key agencies of public sector banks and insurance agencies, New India Assurance and United India.
- ◆ **Raotivu, an Indian island with a checkered past**, has been a focal point of dispute between India and Sri Lanka following its occupation in 1974.

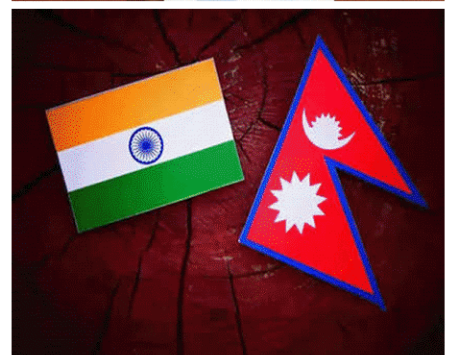
